FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL COUNCILS WHICH HAVE

REGISTERED AT LEAST TWENTY PERCENT (20%) OF THEIR

MEMBERSHIP POTENTIAL

- 1. The National Executive Board (NEB) of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), in its meeting on December 12, 2014, unanimously approved to provide financial assistance to local councils which have registered at least twenty percent (20%) of their membership potential as of the end of December 31 of each year.
- 2. The amount of financial assistance to be given to local councils shall be based on the following scheme:

Classification of

Amount of

Local Councils	Membership Potential	Financial Assistance	
Class A	120,001 and above	Php	30,000.00
Class B	70,001 to 120,000		20,000.00
Class C	36,001 to 70,000		15,000.00
Class D	36,000 and below		10,000.00

- 3. The NEB further approved that the funding of the aforesaid financial assistance shall be derived from the savings or excess funds of the Financial Assistance Program (FAP) of the BSP for each fiscal year.
- 4. The release of the said financial assistance shall commence effective CY 2015 and every year thereafter. The membership data as of the end of December 31 of the prior year shall be the basis if a local council has reached the minimum requirement of having registered at least 20% of its membership potential.
- 5. The NEB may opt to revise or modify the foregoing scheme or other provisions of this Memorandum as it may deem proper.
