

SUBJECT : **TRIBUTE TO THE SCOUTMASTER 2012**

1. We are pleased to announce the National Search for Outstanding Scoutmasters for 2012. This search is open to all Unit Leaders (the word Scoutmaster is used as a generic term to refer to all Unit Leaders in the different Scouting sections of the BSP). The objective of this project is to recognize the outstanding achievements of Unit Leaders in the development of the youth in the country.
2. The selection will be at Council, Regional and National levels. All Local Councils are therefore encouraged to send their nominees for screening at the Regional level. A National Selection Committee will be constituted to make the final screening and selection based on the nominations coming from the region. Regional Offices are requested to submit their nomination at the BSP National Office not later than April 01, 2012 based on the following quota.

4. The Tribute to the Scoutmaster Awarding Ceremony for this event is scheduled during the conduct of 56th Annual National Council Meeting in May 16-18, 2012 in Mindanao.
5. Cash Prizes will be awarded to the winners. Transportation expenses of the winners to and from their Local Councils to the venue, including an overnight board and lodging, shall be borne by the National Office, BSP.
