- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines on its 5<sup>th</sup> Year of active participation to this world event enjoins all Local Councils, Scouts and Scout Leaders to organize and/or participate in the upcoming 2015 EARTH HOUR CELEBRATION on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2015 (Saturday) 08:30 PM local time.
- 2. This event aims to increase the level of awareness among communities and be able to adapt to climate change, learn and switch to clean sources of renewable energy, infuse sustainability and send an even stronger message to our society to **take positive action against global warming.**
- 3. The Earth Hour is a worldwide grass-roots movement under World Wildlife Fund (www.wwf.org) for the planet that engages a massive mainstream community on a broad range of environmental issues. The event is held worldwide towards the end of March annually, encouraging individuals, communities' households, businesses, government agencies and private corporations to turn-off their non-essential lights for one (1) hour as a symbol for their commitment to save the planet.

In the past years, Local Councils were invited by various SM Supermalls in their areas nationwide and participated in their Symbolic Switch-Off & Candle Lighting Ceremony and the Signing of the Earth Hour Commitment Wall. For further information, all concerned are advised to coordinate with the SM Supermalls in your respective areas.

Scout Troops, Senior Scout Outfits and Rover Circles may opt to organize their Local Events in schools and communities by holding an Earth Hour Symposium (Climate Change and Global Warming), Film Showing about Global Warming and Climate Change, Scout Youth Forum, Slogan, Logo and Poster Making during their Unit and Sub-Unit Meetings.
