SUBJECT: 2015 TRIBUTE TO THE SCOUTMASTER

- We are pleased to announce the National Search for Outstanding Scoutmasters for 2014. This
 search is open to all Unit Leaders. The word Scoutmaster is used as a generic term for all Unit
 Leaders in the different Scouting sections of the BSP. The objective of this project is to
 recognize the outstanding achievements of Unit Leaders in the development of the youth in the
 country.
- The selection will be at Council, Regional and National levels. All Sponsoring Institutions are therefore encouraged to send their nominees for initial screening at the Local Council level after which qualified/approved nominees shall be endorsed to the Regional Selection Committee together with all supporting documents. Regional Offices are required to organize their Regional Selection Committee and submit the nomination to the BSP National Office not later than 13 April 2015. A National Selection Committee will be constituted to make the final screening and selection based on the nominations coming from the Region, the following is the allocation per Region:

31 March - Regional level screening and selection of nominees.

13 April - Deadline for submission of final nominees, nomination form

and accompanying documents at National level.

20 April - Evaluation of documents by the National Office BSP Technical

Working Group.

28 April - Final evaluation of the documents and accompanying documents by

the National Board of Judges.

21 May - Awarding Ceremony during the conduct of 59th ANCM.

- 5. The Tribute to the Scoutmaster Awarding Ceremony for this event is scheduled during the conduct of the 59th Annual National Council Meeting on May 21 2015.
- 6. Cash Prizes will be awarded to the winners. Transportation expenses of the winners to and from their Local Councils to the venue, including an overnight board and lodging, shall be borne by the National Office, BSP.
