
TO : REGIONAL SCOUT DIRECTORS

SUBJECT : COMPLIANCE TO THE REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO CONDUCT A NATIONAL COURT OF HONOR FOR EAGLE SCOUTS

1. National Office Memorandum No. 51, series of 2012 on National Guidelines and Procedures in Processing the Application for Eagle Scout Rank No. 6 and its inclusion states that:

"The Regional Office applies for Authority to Conduct a Special National Board of Review for Eagle Scout Rank to the National Office, BSP addressed to the Secretary General thru the Director of Field Operations Division, BSP. The application letter shall include the following information:

- a. The Council requesting the conduct of the Board of Review
 - b. Date and Time of the Board of Review
 - c. Venue of the Board of Review
 - d. Members of the Panel of the Board of Review and their current Position/Designation and Qualification
 - e. Names of Eagle Scout Candidates
 - f. The Regional Office shall attest to the fact all Scout Advancement Folders are complete and in order"
2. Anent this provision, all Local Councils are hereby reminded and instructed to comply with the specified requirements.
 3. A proper endorsement must be forwarded to the Regional Office fifteen (15) days after the conduct of the Board of review. The Regional Office will then endorse and forward all required documents to the National Office for appropriate action.
 4. Upon the approval of the National Office, the Local Councils will then apply for a Conduct of the National Court of Honor to the Regional Office and the National Office respectively. A National Court of Honor will be conducted IF and ONLY IF all requirements stated above are strictly complied.
 5. For information and strict compliance.
