TO : Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives and Officers-In-Charge

### SUBJECT: 58th ANNUAL NATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING (ANCM)

- Pursuant to the provisions of R.A. 7278 and the By-laws governing the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, the National Executive Board (NEB) has approved the holding of the 58<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL NATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING (ANCM) on 19-22 May 2014 at the Bacolod Business Inn Hotel, Lacson Street, Bacolod City.
- 2. Details of the conference are as follows:
  - a. Purpose : As provided in Section 1, Article V of the BSP National Bylaws, the Annual National Council Meeting shall be convened to:
    - Receive reports of the National President and the National Treasurer;
    - Elect four (4) regular members of the National Executive Board;
    - Ratifying any proposed amendments to the BSP Bylaws (if any);
    - Conduct the National Court of Honor & other Recognitions; and,
    - Other business as may properly come before the meeting
  - **b.** Special features in the conference are awards ceremonies for:
    - 2014 Tribute to the Scoutmaster
    - 2013 Outstanding Regional/Council Commissioners
    - 2013 Outstanding Regional/Council Chairmen
    - 2013 Lorillard Spencer Trophy Award

### c. Participation:

- 1. **Official Conference Delegates** are:
  - a. National Executive Board Members
  - b. Regional Chairmen
  - c. Regional Scout Commissioners
  - d. Council Chairmen
  - e. Council Scout Commissioners
  - f. Officially designated Council Executive Board Member(s)
  - g. Council Scout Executives/Officers-In-Charge (observer)

For the election of regular members to the NEB, each Local Council shall be entitled to four (4) votes only, but will be entitled to one (1) additional vote for every ten thousand (10,000) of its Scout Membership as of December 2013. The additional vote(s) shall be cast only by the Head of Delegation.

Local Council Scout Executives attending the conference without any other delegate, appointed by their Local Council Executive Board shall be allowed to vote in behalf of the council's voting delegate, <u>provided that a Council Executive Board resolution shall be submitted to the BSP National Office not later than 31 March 2014.</u>

- 2. **Observers** other Regional and Local Council Officers who desire to attend the conference may do so as Observers. <u>They can participate in the deliberations but shall have no right to vote.</u>
- 3. **Credentials** participants are **REQUIRED** to present their current membership cards when they register for the conference.
- d. **Conference Fee:** Each participant will be assessed a conference fee of **Three Thousand (Php3,000.00) Pesos** to cover cost of meals (*from afternoon snack of 20 May 2014 until lunch of 22 May 2014*), conference materials and souvenirs. Breakfast shall be for the account of the delegates/observers.
- e. **Attire:** <u>All participants</u> are expected to wear the official Scout uniform (Type "A" Uniform) for the Opening Ceremonies, Closing Ceremonies and during Awarding Ceremonies for the Tribute to the Scoutmaster, Outstanding Regional/Council Scout Commissioners, Regional/Council Chairmen and National Court of Honor.
- 3. Nominations for Regular Membership and Private Sector Representatives in the National Executive Board <u>must be submitted to the Committee on Nominations and Election, c/o Acting Secretary General, BSP National Office, 181 Natividad Almeda-Lopez Street, Ermita, Manila **not later than 31 March 2014**. Nominations sent by mail and postmarked on or before this date shall be considered.</u>
- 4. The accomplished Notice of Attendance, together with the request for NaFCO withdrawals should reach BSP National Office on or before 31 March 2014. Cash payments may be made at the National Office or at the conference venue. NaFCO authorization brought to the conference venue will not be entertained.
- 5. All Regional/Local Councils are hereby enjoined to have a full complement of delegates considering the importance of this conference.
