NATIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM FOR LUZON AND MINDANAO

 The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the holding of the National Scout Youth Forum for Luzon and Mindanao to be held at the following venues and dates to wit;

LUZON – Venue: National Office, Manila. Date: 19-21 March 2015 MINDANAO – Venue: Camp Malagos, Davao City. 19-21 March 2015

- 2. The Scout Youth Forum, a primordial part of the Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for youth participation in the decision-making process in the Scout Movement. It is a place for information, training and concrete experience of discussing and acquiring a deeper understanding of various issues affecting young people and society. It is also a source of inspiration by providing the contact with new people, fresh ideas, innovative thoughts, different experiences and working methods.
- 3. **Generals Qualifications.** For an individual to qualify to participate in a Scout Youth Forum, the following standards must be met:

#### For Senior Scouts

- Must be a currently registered Senior Scouts
- b. Must have been elected in prior levels of the Scout Youth Forum
- c. Must have an official Type A Scout Uniform

## For Accompanying Adults

- a. Must be a currently registered Adult Leader
- b. Must have been officially designated by the Regional Office
- c. Must have an official Type A Scout Uniform
- d. Must be fully conversant about the Scout Youth Forum

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- 4. Participation. Each Region shall send six (6) offficial Forum delegates only, duly elected in their respective Regional Scout Youth Forum. Likewise, there must only be one member of the organizing committee per Region officially designated and endorsed by the Regional Scout Director. Each Region is also allowed to send a maximun of two (2) Observers to the Scout Youth Forum, but shall have no voting right. The right of those Scouts representing their respective Regions to the National Scouth Youth Forum is strictly not transferable.
- Registration fee. Participants shall be charged a registration fee to defray expenses for the accommodation, food, program materials and other operations expenses. LUZON
  - One Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Five Pesos (Php 1,625.00) for Voting Delegates, Organizing Committee and;
  - Two Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Pesos (Php 2,125.00) for accompaying Adult Leaders

#### **MINDANAO**

 One Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php 1,400.00) for Voting Delegates, Organizing Committeee, Observers and Adults

**Note:** Adults must pay the full P500/day accommodation fee for Luzon only the Scouts get a 50% discount.
