SUBJECT: 2014 NATIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM FOR LUZON

- 1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the holding of the 2014 National Scout Youth Forum for Luzon to be held at the Conference Hall, BP International Hotel, 6/F BSP National Office Building, Ermita, Manila on 21-23 March 2014.
- 2. The Scout Youth Forum, a primordial part of the Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for youth participation in the decision-making process in the Scout Movement. It is a place for information, training and concrete experience of discussing and acquiring a deeper understanding of various issues. It is also a source of inspiration by providing the contact with new people, fresh ideas, innovative thoughts, different experiences and working methods.
- 3. **General Qualifications.** For an individual to qualify to participate in a Scout Youth Forum, the following standards must be met:

For Senior Scouts

- a. Must be a currently registered Senior Scout
- b. Must have been elected in prior levels of the Scout Youth Forum
- c. Must have an official Type A Scout Uniform

For Accompanying Adults

- a. Must be a currently registered Adult Leader
- b. Must have been officially designated by the Regional Office
- c. Must have an official Type A Scout Uniform
- d. Must be fully conversant about the Scout Youth Forum
- 4. Participation. Relative to National Office Memorandum No. 15, Series of 2014, each Region shall send six (6) official Forum Delegates only, duly elected in their respective Regional Scout Youth Forums. Likewise, there must only be two (2) Accompanying Adults per Region, duly designated and endorsed by the Regional Scout Director.

Each region is also allowed to send a maximum of three (3) Observers on top of the required number of delegates to the Scout Youth Forum, but shall have no voting rights.

The **voting rights** of those Scouts duly elected to represent their respective Regions to the National Scout Youth Forum are **strictly not transferrable**.

- 5. **Registration Fee.** Participants (Voting Delegates and Observers) and Accompanying Adults shall be charged a Registration Fee amounting to **THREE THOUSAND PESOS (Php 3, 000.00)** to defray expenses for the accommodation, food, program materials and other operational expenses.
- 6. **Organizing Committee.** The following incumbent Scout Representatives are hereby designated to constitute the Organizing Committee:

7. **Forum Adviser.** To assist, support and counsel the Organizing Committee in the holding of the National Scout Youth Forum, KENNY RALPH S. FERNANDO, Assistant Program Officer of the Field Operations Division is hereby designated as Forum Adviser.

Per National Office Memorandum No. 15, Series of 2014, the Forum Adviser shall be the only adult leader that is allowed to intervene in the conduct of the Forum.

- 8. Reporting Time. All Participants and Accompanying Adults must check in at the venue not later than 4PM of 20 March 2014 (Thursday) and are to stay until the Closing Ceremonies at 10AM of 23 March 2014 (Sunday).
- 9. **Meals.** Meals will be served from **Dinner** of **20 March 2014 (Thursday)** until **Lunch** of **23 March 2014 (Sunday).**
- 10. **Special Instructions.** Participants are advised to bring the following: (a) reference materials, (b) laptops, (c) civilian clothes, including jackets and (d) maintenance medicines.
- 11. **Attachments and Deadlines.** Herewith attached with this mail are the (1) General Program of Activities and (2) General Information Sheet.
