SUBJECT: COMPUTER ACCESS MENTORSHIP PROGRAM (CAMP)

1. In collaboration with the Sa Aklat Sisikat Foundation (SAS) and Department of Education (DepEd), we are pleased to inform all concerned that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) has launched the project "Computer Access Mentorship Program" (CAMP), which aims to establish computer access and mentorship sites in strategically located BSP Local Council Offices located near to or within public school compounds in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao. This pilot online program is funded by the Asian Development Bank.
2. The CAMP sites will train 9,000 private and public elementary school teachers over a span of three consecutive years and will deliver a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of eight (8) hours of training to highly motivated teachers and volunteers who are dedicated and capable of transforming their students into a strong and able readers and better learners.
3. The establishment of CAMP online project by the DepEd, SAS and the BSP throughout the country is anchored on the vision of nurturing teachers, in order to build a nation of readers and in pursuit of their objectives to:
 - a) empower teachers;
 - b) innovate and improve teacher practice and foster a pupil centred (versus lecture driven) active learning environment; and
 - c) enhance student learning by giving public school teachers' access to ICT.
4. With this CAMP Project, our Scout Leaders who are also private and public elementary school teachers and volunteers may register and access the online program at this website: www.sasonline.com.ph
5. Please take note that:
 - a) The completion of the online CAMP program will entitle the Scout Leader/teacher/Volunteer to the necessary academic certificates of proficiency by the Department of Education.
 - b) The completion of the online CAMP program will entitle the Scout Leader/teacher/Volunteer to the necessary service credit certificates by the Boy Scouts of the Philippines.
6. Attached to this Memorandum are the MOA and the Amendment to the MOA duly signed by concerned officials.
7. It is desired that this project will be given widest dissemination, vigorous promotion and full implementation.

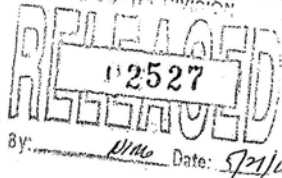

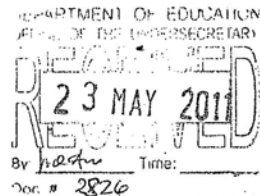

This refers to the attached proposed amendment to the previous Memorandum of Agreement between Sa Aklat Sisikat Foundation, Inc., Boy Scouts of the Philippines and DepEd in the establishment of Computer Access Mentorship Program (CAMP) sites in BSP Council offices throughout the country for training of highly motivated teachers, who are dedicated and capable of transforming their students into strong able readers and better learners.

The Agreement does not involve expenses on the part of DepEd and that perusal of the amendment including the terms and conditions therein are not contrary to law, public order or public policy.

Hence, this kind of Agreement does not require compliance with the Provision of R.A. No. 9184.

However, the above opinion does not cover any irregularities or anomalies which may have been committed but not apparent from records presented to the office of the undersigned.

AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement entered into this 11th day of January, 2010, in Makati City, by and among:

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, with principal office address at the DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, herein represented by its Secretary, the Honorable **BR. ARMIN LUISTRO FSC**, hereinafter referred to as **DepEd**.

SA AKLAT SISIKAT FOUNDATION, INC., a non-stock, non-profit corporation duly organized, registered and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with office address at the 35th Floor, Petron Mega Plaza, #358 Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue, Makati City, represented herein by its President, **MARGARITA L. DELGADO**, hereinafter referred to as **SAS**;

BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, non-stock, non-profit organization, created by special law, with office address at # 181 Natividad Lopez St., Ermita, Manila, represented herein by its Secretary General, **JOSE RIZAL C. PANGILINAN**, hereinafter referred to as **BSP**;

- WITNESSETH: THAT -

WHEREAS, the parties, with their vision of nurturing teachers in order to build a nation of readers, and pursuant to their objectives to empower them principally in basic education grades, to innovate and improve teacher practice and foster a pupil-centered (versus lecture-driven) active learning environment and to enhance student learning by giving public school teachers access to ICT, agreed to work jointly and cooperatively to establish "*Computer Access Mentorship Program*" (CAMP) sites throughout the country, previously entered into a Memorandum of Agreement dated January 11, 2010 (hereafter "*Memorandum of Agreement*");

WHEREAS, the parties mutually agree to amend the said Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the mutual covenants, stipulations, terms and conditions herein below specified, the parties have hereunto agreed as follows:

1. The following provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement are to be amended as follows (amendments in italics for ready reference):



A. Article II.A, Paragraphs 1, 2 and 4

"1. A total of *twenty-five (25)* CAMP sites which are accessible to the community of teachers will be selected and put up nationwide over three (3) years. The first *five (5)* sites will be set up on the first year, another *ten (10)* sites on the second year and the last *ten (10)* sites will be on the third year."

"2. These CAMP sites will be approximately twenty-five (25) square meters in size, IT ready and equipped by SAS, using the funds granted by the Asian Development Bank, with *three (3)* desktop computers, *one (1) administrative computer*, *one (1)* printer, wifi, router, scanner and an initial DSL subscription."

"4. The CAMP sites will deliver approximately *five (5) to eight (8)* hours of training to highly motivated teachers, who are dedicated and capable of transforming their students into strong able readers and better learners."

B. Article II.B, Paragraph 7

"7. SAS will supply the *twenty-five (25)* BSP council office rooms, of approximately twenty-five (25) sq. m, with *three (3)* desktop computers, *one (1) administrative computer*, *one (1)* printer, wifi router, scanner and an initial DSL subscription, *where needed*, through the funds of the ADB grant."

C. Article II.C, Paragraph 1

"1. BSP will provide Information Technology ready rooms consisting of twenty-five (25) sq. m. in its *twenty-five (25)* council offices to be used as CAMP Sites and will maintain the hardware which is set up in the room."

D. Article II.D, Paragraphs 3 and 5

"3. DepEd will issue the necessary academic certificate for proficiency to participants, who successfully complete the approximately *five (5) to eight (8)* hours of CAMP site training based on the program guidelines."

"5. DepEd will make accessible to the independent survey entity, contracted by SAS, the schools that will participate in the Camp Sites, as well as a control sample of *twenty-five (25)* schools, so that the survey and measurement study on the


efficacy of the CAMP site on-line teacher training program can be evaluated."

2. All other terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Agreement that have not been hereby amended shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect on _____, and may be amended or modified upon mutual agreement of the parties in writing, and shall *ipso facto* terminate upon satisfactory fulfillment of all the terms and conditions hereof.




