 The National Office, BSP is pleased to announce the conduct of the RISK AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT SEMINAR-WORKSHOP on May 02 - 04, 2012 at the PSC-APR, Mt. Makiling, Los Banos, Laguna

- 2. The Seminar-Workshop aims to create an awareness and understanding of the concept of risk and safety management in relation to Scouting; to stress the importance and advantage of developing and implementing a risk management approach by the BSP; to equip the participants with basic knowledge, tools and resources on risk management; and to present a guideline from the WSB-APR Office to formulate the BSP Policy on Risk and Safety Management.
- 3. As a result of this seminar-workshop, participants are expected to have an understanding of the concept of risk and safety management in Scouting; acquire basic knowledge and skills in risk assessment and management in Scouting activities; and contribute ideas that could be used by the BSP in the development of the risk and safety management policy.
- 4. The seminar-workshop is open to all Scout professionals and volunteer leaders who are directly involve in the planning, organizing and implementing Scouting activities and events.
- Participants shall have the opportunity to practice the acquired skills in seminar, as they will be required to assess the camp facilities installed at the MNSR PSC-APR Mt. Makiling, Los Banos, Laguna.
