SUBJECT : 9th NATIONAL ROVERMOOT

- 1. We are pleased to announce the holding of the 9th National Rover Moot on 22 to 28 October 2012 at Calaca, Batangas with the theme: Be Prepared:"Leadership for Life".
- 2. Unique activities are lined-up for this seven-day event focused mainly on leadership, responsibility, community development, environmental awareness/preservation and fellowship.
- 3. Objectives: At the end of the Rover Moot the participants will be able to:
 - a. Internalize the value of autonomy and responsibility.
 - b. Develop leadership skills and discover the importance of teamwork.
 - c. Create awareness on the value of Environmental Education in Scouting to help save Mother Earth.
 - d. Appreciate the cultural and historical heritage of the host province/city.
 - e. Promote Scouts as "Messengers of Peace" thru Community Immersion Projects.
- 4. The following are the guidelines to determine the contingent requirements:
 - a. **Participation**: For the Rovers and Roverettes 16-24 yrs of age, the participation quota per Region are as follows:

List of participants must reach BSP National Office not later than 24 September 2012. Enclosed is the prescribed Registration Form which you may produce. We also encourage the participation of Senior Scouts (3rd and 4th Year High School Students) for them to start their appreciation of Rover Scouting as a" Brotherhood of the Open Air and Service".

- b. Registration: A Moot Fee of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00) shall be charged each participants to cover expenses for program materials, certificates, individual souvenir items and Administrative costs. A non-refundable but transferable deposit of Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) must be paid to National Office through Local Council on or before 24 September 2012 and full payment shall be made on or before 22 October 2012.
- c. **Equipment**: the Standard Circle equipment is prescribed in activities of this nature. It is suggested that only handy equipment (tent, uniform, cooking gears, sleeping bag, food provisions, costumes, extra clothes, personal kit, etc.) should be brought by every contingent.
- d. **Food**: The contingents will cook their own food. All contingents are expected to have adequate food supply to last for the duration of the Moot.
- e. Transportation: Arrangement for transportation to and from the venue is the responsibility of every Contingent.
