SUBJECT: <u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – 23rd WORLD SCOUT JAMBOREE</u>

Further to National Office Memoranda No. 17 and 28, the following information are hereby provided:

a. SAFE FROM HARM

As mentioned in the Bulletin 4 and 5 of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree, to ensure the Jamboree is held in abuse-free environment, all Unit Leaders, International Service Team members, Jamboree Management Team and other adult Staff will be required to take the **SAFE FROM HARM (SfH) TRAINING** prior to the arrival in Jamboree site. SfH addresses types of abuse such as bullying, harassment, neglect, and exploitation, treating them as behavior that can occur between Scouts, between Scouts and adults and between adults and focuses on how to prevent such behavior.

Online training will be available from April 2015. The online training platform will open on the Jamboree website Scout Association of Japan e-Learning: ログイン画面. Each individual will be able to create an account and start the online training course. The training will consist of modules; each module having a presentation format and covering a specific topic. The training will be available in English, and it will take 90 minutes to complete the 9 modules and the final test.

Upon completing the training, an individual will receive a certificate, which certified that you has completed the SfH Training. Printed copy of the certificate should be presented upon arrival at the Jamboree site.

The BSP National Office required all Unit Leaders, International Service Team members, Jamboree Management Team and other adult Staff to submit a copy of your certificate thru email to butch.isidoro@scouts.org.ph to update your online registration on or before May 30, 2015.

b. INSURANCE:

Further to the Bulletin No. 6 of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree all contingents are **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** to obtain appropriate insurance (including medical cover). If the participant need clinical examination or treatment at medical facilities in Japan, it will be very expensive (on average about JPY15,000.00 per night or Php5,700.00 per night).

During the Philippine National Task Group meeting headed by the Engr. Leo G. Lasacar, Contingent Head of the Philippine Delegation approved to **REQUIRE** all the participants (Contingent Management Team, Unit Leaders, Senior Scouts and International Service Team) to get their own Travel Insurance (during the travel) covering accidental death, accidental permanent disability, sickness death, accidental medical expenses, sickness medical expenses and liability.

c. CULTURAL EXCHANGE DAY

The World Scout Jamboree will conduct the CULTURAL EXCHANGE DAY on 2nd August 2015 will comprise a number of major events held at the Jamboree site, turning the whole Jamboree into a great festival with music, performances, games, foods, etc. All Philippine Delegates are recommended to prepare/bring some items like pastillas, delicacies from your province and local games for this one day event.

d. REGISTRATION FOR THE JAMBOREE

The Boy Scouts of the Philippine is still accepting participants (Senior Scouts and International Service Team Members) until 15 May 2015. However, there will be a five percent (5%) surcharge that will be added to the Jamboree fee based on the Term s and Conditions of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree.

e. LIST OF THE PHILIPPINE DELEGATES

As of 31 March 2015, herewith the list of the Philippine Delegates who are registered online and remitted the Jamboree Fee (see annex "A").

f. DAY VISITOR

Based on the Bulletin No. 6 of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree, the jamboree is open for Day Visitors to come and experience the spirit of the Scouting on 7 fantastic days from 9:00 to 17:00, as follows:

Thursday, 30th July 2015 Friday, 31st July 2015 Saturday, 1st August 2015 Monday, 3rd August 2015 Tuesday, 4th August 2015 Wednesday, 5th August 2015 Thursday, 5th August 2015

The maximum numbers of Day Visitors allowed per day is 5,000. Day Visitors are requested to purchase entrance ticket in advance. A ticket sale is available on at the Jamboree website www.23wsj.jp.

A Day Visitor ticket is JPY2,000.00 or Php760.00 (14 years old and above) for adult and JPY1,000.00 or Php380.00 for children (7 to 13 years old).

The BSP encourages all interested BSP Members/Day Visitors to visit the Jamboree site preferably on the 3rd of August 2015 (Monday) to join and witness the celebration of the Philippine Reception Day of the Contingent, 1300H at Jamboree Reception Hall.

The BSP will organize the Day Visitor/Visiting Group from 01-05 August 2015 in Fukuoka Area. All interested BSP members should submit the BSP International Application Form **on or before 30 April 2015** endorsed by your Local Council and Regional Offices.

g. VISA REQUIREMENTS:

Upon approval of participants' application by the Scout Association of Japan (SAJ), the International Section, Field Operations Division, BSP, shall arrange the contingent Japan Visa on the month of May 2015. All participants MUST submit the complete requirements <u>on or before</u> <u>30 April 2015</u>, as follows:

- Visa Application Form completely filled up
- A Valid Philippine Passport (old and new), undamaged
- Three (3) Passport Size Colored Photos with White Background
- Supporting documents needed during interview (all originals)

A. For Adults

- Bank Certification/s with Bankbook
- Certificate of Employment including applicant's position, working record and monthly/annual income and approved leave of absent
- If self-employed Business Name/Permit or SEC Registration
- Birth Certificate and Marriage Certificate (if married) with NSO security paper
- Latest Individual Income Tax Return (ITR)
- If government employee, Authority to Travel is required

B. For Scouts

- DSWD Certificate to Travel for Minors
- Affidavit of Support and Consent of Parents
- Parent Bank Certification/s with Bankbook
- Parent Current Income Tax Return (ITR)
- Parent Certificate of Employment/Business Name/Permit or SEC Registration
- School ID and Certification of Enrolment/Registration
- Birth Certificate with NSO Security Paper
- Parent Birth Certificate and Marriage Contract with NSO Security Paper
