- ✓ Promote responsible consumer-behavior and developmental practices that respect all forms of life and preserve the balance-cycle of natural resources and protection of the environment;
- ✓ Be sensitive to the difficulties and suffering of others, especially the marginalized, displaced, differently-abled and people in extremely difficult circumstances;
