

**SUBJECT :** ASIA-PACIFIC REGIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE NEEDS AND CHALLENGES OF YOUNG PEOPLE AND ADULTS IN SCOUTING

1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the **Asia-Pacific Regional Seminar-Workshop on the Needs and Challenges of Young People and Adults in Scouting** in partnership with the World Scout Bureau – Asia Pacific Region (WSB-APR) at the **Multi-Purpose Hall, 15/F BSP National Office Building, Ermita, Manila** on **2-5 June 2015**.
2. The subject Seminar-Workshop aims to provide an effective avenue for key leaders at the regional, national and sub-national levels among Chairpersons, Vice Chairpersons and members of the APR Adult Support and Programme Sub-Committees, the member-NSO's Adult in Scouting Committees, Training Commissioners, Youth Programme Commissioners and Young Adult Group members to strengthen adult support in the implementation of a better Youth Programme.
3. The event will host the delegates from the **twenty six (26) National Scout Organizations in the Asia-Pacific Region**, including National, Regional and Council Commissioners of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines involved in Youth Program and Adults in Scouting.
4. **Registration Fee.** A Registration Fee amounting to **TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00)** shall be charged per participant in order to defray the administrative costs, materials and handouts, equipment, food, accommodation, training facilities, Seminar-Workshop kits and souvenirs.
5. **Venue and Reporting Time.** Participants must report at the **Baden Powel International Hotel** not later than **1800H of 1 June 2015 (Monday)** and are to stay at the venue not later than **1000H of 6 June 2015 (Saturday)**.
6. **Food.** Food for the participants will be provided from **Dinner of 1 June 2015 (Monday)** until **Breakfast of 6 June 2015 (Saturday)**.
7. **Deadline.** Due to the limited number of slots allotted for local participation, the attached Application Form must be sent electronically to [kenny.fernando@scouts.org.ph](mailto:kenny.fernando@scouts.org.ph) or via courier service to the Field Operations Division. The applications must be duly endorsed by the Local Council and the Regional Office.
8. **Attire.** The participants must be in their Type "A" Scout Uniform with Gilwell Tokens during formal ceremonies. They are also to bring their respective national costumes and attire for the socials.
