SUBJECT: SG50 INTERNATIONAL JAMBOREE (SINGAPORE)

- 1. We are pleased to inform you that upon invitation of the Scout Association of Singapore (SSA), the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will organize a contingent to represent the Philippines in the aforementioned event.
- 2. The basic information to the said activities are as follows:

a. Date:

17-22 November 2015, participants must arrive on the morning of 17 November and leave the Jamboree site by noon of 22 November 2015.

b. Theme:

Celebrating Our Journey, Home, Friendship, Adventure and Dreams

c. Participants:

- a. Scout Applicants
 - Boy/Senior Scout 13-17 years of age
 - Duly registered Boy/Senior Scout
 - At least a Venturer Rank Holder or equivalent
 - Must be physically fit and in good health
 - The Scout must have attended BSP Regional/National Scout Jamboree

b. Adult Leader Applicants

- Duly registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines
- At least five (5) years experience as a Unit Leader, preferably Woodbadge holder
- Must be physically fit and in good health
- The Unit Leader must have attended BSP Regional/National Scout Jamboree
- c. International Service Team Applicants
 - Duly registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines
 - Must be physically fit and in good health
 - The IST must served as NST/Staff in BSP Council/Regional/National Jamboree

Mode of Selection: The National Office, BSP reserves the right to select the members of the delegation based, firstly on qualification and secondly, on a first reservation acceptance basis.

As per international standards, the Jamboree composition is one (1) adult leader for every nine (9) Scouts, the approval of adult application will be dependent on the total number of participating Scouts.

All prospective participants attending International Jamboree MUST attend the pre-Jamboree training to be conducted by the BSP National Office.
