

SPECIALIST PANEL**

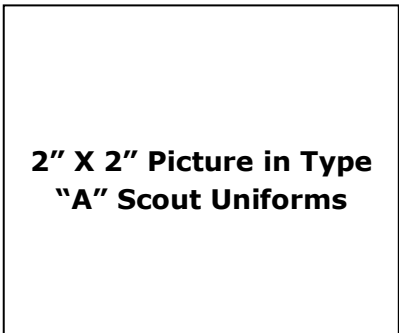
1. The National Office, BSP pleased to announce the **"OPEN CALL FOR VOLUNTEER MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL SPECIALIST PANEL"** to be part of the dynamic team of volunteers who will compose different task groups under Youth Program and Adults in Scouting (Adult Training and Management).
2. This project aims to draw from the full talent and resources available within our organization for these working groups. The "Open Call" is for interested volunteers to support the work of the Program and Adults in Scouting Committee in the areas of Educational Methods (Youth Program, Training and Adult Resources).
3. This call for Volunteer-Members of the National Specialist Panel is OPEN to all registered Adults in Scouting (Unit Leaders and Leaders of Adults) in good standing in their respective Local Councils and preferably members of the Training Team with the minimum qualification of an Assistant Leader Trainer. Leaders of Adults with specialized skills and expertise in various subject-matters are welcome to submit their application. Areas of Specialization may include but are not limited to:
 - a. Program Development
 - b. Curriculum Writing and Content Development
 - c. Training and Development
 - d. Safety and Risk Management
 - e. Disaster and Risk Reduction Management
 - f. Information Communication Technology
 - g. Vocational and Technical Skills
 - h. Community Development
 - i. Outdoor and Survival Skills
 - j. High Adventure Activities (e.g. Air, Land and Sea Scouting)
 - k. Human Resources Development
4. Successful candidates will be clustered into two (2) groups under the (i) Youth Program Development and (ii) Adults in Scouting, while Task Groups are broken down into Sectional Programs for KID, KAB, Boy, Senior, Rover, Community-Based Scouting and NSTP-CWTS Scouting, respectively. All qualified applicants must be duly endorsed by their Council Scout Executive and recommended by the Regional Scout Director.
5. Task group work mode will be a combination of face-to-face meeting and online collaboration. A general meeting will be set and succeeding task group assignments will be sent online supported by with draft task group documents and will be submitted thru email. All these will be consolidated and facilitated by the PARD Unit of the Field Operations Division, National Office, BSP.
6. The deadline for submission of application is on or before 31 August 2015 and must be sent to fod@scouts.org.ph and yaz.sarona@scouts.org.ph. All successful applicants will receive an official letter of appointment from National Office thru their respective Local Councils copy furnished the Regional Offices.
