- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, in partnership with the World Scout Bureau Asia-Pacific Regional Support Center, is pleased to announce the conduct of the Asia-Pacific Regional Workshop on Partnership and Self-Reliance at the Multi-Purpose Hall, 15/F BSP National Office Building, Ermita, Manila on 16-21 September 2015.

A Registration Fee amounting to TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) shall be charged per participant in order to defray the administrative costs, Workshop materials and handouts, meals (from Dinner of 17 September until Breakfast of 21 September 2015, accommodation (check in time at 2PM of 17 September and check out time at 12NN of 21 September 2015), Workshop kits and souvenirs.
