SUBJECT : AMENDMENTS TO NATIONAL OFFICE MEMORANDUM NO. 52, SERIES OF 2015
RE: 56TH ANNUAL NATIONAL SCOUT EXECUTIVES CONFERENCE

In line with the holding of the 56th Annual National Scout Executives Conference at the Multi-Purpose Hall, 15/F BSP National Office Building, Ermita, Manila on 14-18 December 2015, all concerned are hereby informed of the following details, extended deadlines and corresponding adjustments:

1. **Conference Schedule.** The Opening Ceremony will commence at **1330H** instead of **1500H** of **14 December 2015, Monday**. Hence, all participants to the Conference are requested to be at the venue on or before **1200H**, and are to check-in at the Baden Powell International Hotel **on or before 1200H**.

The revised Conference Schedule is herein attached as “Annex A” for your reference.

2. **Uniform Sizes (Executive Jacket and Sports Uniform).** Due to logistical constraints in the production of the uniforms, the sizes will now conform to the standard clothing sizes of Extra Small, Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large, Double XL, etc. instead of the required individual measurements.

All participants are required to transmit their corresponding sizes to the Field Operations Division **not later than 16 November 2015, Monday**.

3. **Confirmation of Attendance, NAFCO Withdrawals and Payments.** To reiterate, the accomplished Notice of Attendance, together with the Authorization for NAFCO Withdrawals (if applicable), must reach the BSP National Office **not later than 30 November 2015, Monday** for processing and approval. Authorization for NAFCO Withdrawals brought and handed over during the actual conduct of the Conference will not be entertained and **THERE WILL BE NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION**.

Mechanics. Knock-out System will be applied. Each team will undergo a draw-lot in order to determine the proper sequencing (Team A to Team E).

Order of Games:

- a. Team A vs. Team B
- b. Team C vs. Team D
- c. Winner of Game 1 vs Winner of Game 2
- d. Loser of Game 1 vs Team E
- e. Loser of Game 2 vs Team E
- f. Championship = Team with the most number of wins during Games 4 and 5 vs. Winner of Game 3
- g. Battle for 3rd Place = Loser of Game 3 vs Team with Rank No. 2 during Games 4 and 5.

1. Basketball

- There will be five (5) players per team playing inside the whole court.
- Each team can have as many players they want as substitutes or reserve players.
- A maximum of 30 minutes per game will be applied and will change court every 15 minutes.
- Team will be given 3 minutes warm-up before the game and during half-time.
- Each team will also be given 2 time-outs per game of 1 minute per time-out.
- In case there is a tie in the team score after the game, a 5-bonus free throws per team will be applied as the tie breaker.
- The International Amateur Law of Basketball will be implemented.

2. Badminton

- Team of two (2) men and women. All teams will have a maximum of three (3) reserve players per team.
- Substitution during the game will be allowed upon the discretion or rules set by the referee/umpire.
- Race to 30 points and will change court upon reaching 15 points.

3. Chess

- Timer will be installed during the game.
- Each player will be given maximum of one (1) minute per turn.

4. Darts

- One player per Team
- Men and Women Category

5. AdvenTours

- All players of the team can join this activity. This is not a race competition but the team will be awarded based on the task completed correctly during the activity. It is a fun a relaxing activity were everyone is encouraged to participate.

1. 1st Place – 100 points
2. 2nd Place – 75 points
3. 3rd Place – 50 points
4. 4th Place – 25 points
