

TO : Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives and Officers-In-Charge

SUBJECT : **2018 TRIBUTE TO THE TEN OUTSTANDING SCOUTMASTERS (TOSM)**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the 2018 National Search for The Ten Outstanding Scoutmasters to recognize the outstanding achievements of Unit Leaders in the training and development of Scouts in the country. This search is open to all currently registered Unit Leaders. The word "Scoutmaster" is used as a generic term for all Unit Leaders in the five Scouting sections of the BSP.
2. The selection process will be at the District /Municipal, Council, Regional and National levels and, will be done as follows:
 - a. The District/Municipal Scouting Committees shall schedule and conduct their own screening to select one candidate for the Local Council selection. The Local Council will then select one (1) winner from among the District candidates to be endorsed to the Regional Selection Committee together with all the supporting documents and rating sheets.
 - b. The District/Municipal, Council and Regional Scouting Committee are required to organize their respective Selection Committee.
 - c. The Selection Committee at the District/Municipal/ Council/Regional level shall be composed of the following:

- d. A National Selection Committee will be constituted to select the winners from Regional winners based on the nominations submitted by the Regional Selection Committees.

- e. There shall be thirteen (13) National finalists (Regional winners) viz:


- f. The timetable for the Selection of the Ten Outstanding Scoutmasters for 2018, shall be strictly observed as follows:

31 January	-	Deadline for submission of nominations from the District/Municipal Scouting Committee to the Council Office.
07 February	-	Council level screening and selection.
14 February	-	Deadline for submission of nominations using the Official Nomination form and accompanying documents to the Regional Office.
26 February	-	Regional level screening and selection of winners.
9 March	-	Deadline for submission of Regional winners, with supporting documents to National Office.
21-23 March	-	Review/Evaluation of Nominations by the TOSM 2018 Technical Working Group.
20 April	-	Declaration of winners by the National Board of Judges (NBJ).
07 May	-	Awarding of winners during the conduct of the 62 nd ANCM.

3. Winners shall receive the following:

- a. Council Winners - Certificate of Recognition.


- b. Regional Winners - Certificate of Recognition and souvenir t-shirt.

 - > Reimbursement of Transportation expenses
 - > Board and lodging before and after the awarding ceremony.
4. All Councils and Regional Offices are required to conduct the 2018 Search for the Ten Outstanding Scoutmasters as scheduled and submit After Action Report to the Project Officer not later than **9 March 2018**.
 5. The standard Entry Form must be accomplished by the Nominee, and certified by the Council Scout Executive.

2018 SEARCH FOR THE TEN OUTSTANDING SCOUTMASTERS

RATING STANDARD CRITERIA/GUIDELINES

- I. **CONTRIBUTION TO THE REALIZATION OF THE OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSE OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES (50%)**
- a. **MORAL CHARACTER (10%)** - Certification from his/her religious spiritual leader/adviser that will vouch for his/her moral character.
 - b. **TESTIMONY OF FIVE PROMINENT FORMER SCOUTS (10%)**— Two points is given for every testimonial of his/her former Scout. Prominent person as one having supervisory position in the company/organization or a public official from Punong Barangay up or a successful businessman or professional. *(Maximum of 10 points)*.
 - c. **SERVED CONTINUOUSLY AS UNIT LEADER FOR NOT LESS THAN TEN (10) YEARS NOT NECESSARILY IN ONE INSTITUTION/UNIT (10%)** – The number of years of services as Scoutmaster are validated from the Scout testimonial, CSEs certification, date or formal training/course attended, etc., viz:

10 – 15 years	-	2.5 points
16 – 20 years	-	5 points
21 – 25 years	-	7.5 points
26 years and above	-	10 points
 - d. **ADVANCEMENT OF HIS/HER SCOUTS** (e.g. Growing Usa, Leaping Usa, Second Class, First Class, Explorer, Pathfinder, Outdoorsman, Venturer, Eagle) (15 %) – Ratings are based on the advancement reports submitted. One point for every advancement report signed/acknowledged by the Council office/Regional Office/National Office.
 - e. **LIST OF AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS RECEIVED BY HIS/HER UNIT (5%)** - One point for every award/recognition received. *(Maximum of 5 points)*.
- II. **AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS (20%)** - Recipient of International, National , Regional and Local Awards from Scouting. Certified true copy and pictures of Awards citation must be attached to the form. *(Maximum of 15 points)*.
- a. **SCOUTING AWARDS RECEIVED (15%)**

Bronze Service Award (BSA)	-	1.5
Silver Service Award (SSA)	-	3.0
Gold Service Award (GSA)	-	4.5
Bronze Medal of Merit (BMM)	-	6.0
Silver Medal of Merit (SMM)	-	7.5

 - b. **OTHER SCOUTING RECOGNITIONS (5%)** – One point for every recognition/certificate received. *(Maximum of 5 points)*.

III. SERVICE TO OTHERS (15%)

- a. INVOLVEMENT IN THE COMMUNITY (District/Council) (5%) – One point for every certificate verified. (Maximum of 5 points).

- b. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (District/Council) (10%) – Points is given to Community Project implemented completer with project description, duration, with reports duly acknowledged. Ex. Solid Waste Management/Environmental Project/Anti-Drug Campaign, Water Shade, etc. (Maximum of 5 points).
