### NATIONAL OFFICE MEMORANDUM NO. 8 Series of 2018

SUBJECT: NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERS' SUMMIT 2018

- The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Youth Formation Division (YFD) in coordination with the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) and the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will hold the NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERS SUMMIT 2018 on 18 22 February 2018 at the Helena Z. Benitez National Program and Training Center (NZB NPTC), Calamba Road, Sungay East, Tagaytay City.
- The Summit is in line with DepEd's effort to engage both organizations to come together to develop
  their leadership skills and decision making, and have in depth discussions on relevant issues today
  concerning the youth particularly on Drug Prevention and Awareness, Adolescent Health Program,
  Disaster Preparedness, 21st Century Skills, Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the 10Point Agenda Program.
- Qualifications. The event is open to all qualified individuals who have met the following qualifications stated below:

#### a. For Senior Scouts

- i. Must be currently registered Senior Scout;
- ii. Must have an official Type A Scout Uniform;
- iii. Preferably a Regional or Council Scout Representative;
- iv. At least a Venturer Scout Rank Holder;
- v. Must have attended Council, Regional and National Scout Youth Forum as Forum Participant;
- vi. Must have attended a Council, Regional and National Scout Jamborees; and
- Must be willing to re-echo and/or undertake programs, projects and activities jointly with local GSP counterparts.

#### b. For Adult Leaders

- i. Must be currently registered as an Outfit Advisor
- ii. Must have an official Type A Scout Uniform
- iii. Must be at least a Wood Badge Holder
- Must have an experience accompanying Senior Scouts to Youth Forum, Seminar-Workshops and Scout Jamborees;
- Must be willing to re-echo and/or undertake programs, projects and activities jointly with local GSP counterparts.

 Quota Allocation. The event is limited to 40 Slots Only. Thirty (30) slots are allotted to Senior Scouts and Ten (10) Adult Leaders equally distributed to all ten (10) Scouting Regions, viz:

The Regional Scout Directors shall oversee the selection and endorsement of the participants strictly based on the qualifications stated above, subject for confirmation by the National Office. The Regional Scout Directors must see to it that the participants possess the required qualifications, maturity, commitment and responsibility to ensure that the program will reach the target beneficiaries when implemented.

- 5. Registration Details. For your information, hereunder are the details of the registration.
  - a. Registration Fees. The event is an activity that is fully subsidized by the BSP National Office; hence, participation is FREE OF CHARGE. However, the travel expenses to and from the activity venue shall be shouldered personally by the participants, or by the participating institution, Local Council or Scouting Region, as the case may be.
  - b. Registration Deadline. All Application Forms (please see attached) duly endorsed by the Local Council and the Regional Office must be submitted to the Project Management Team not later than 31 January 2018, Wednesday thru any of the following:
    - i. Via E-Mail boyet.francia@scouts.org.ph / janneasuncion@scouts.org.ph;
    - ii. Via Courier Service Kindly address the parcel / documents to Mr. Carmelo B. Francia at the Field Operations Division
  - c. Notice of Confirmation. Confirmation will be send to all qualified and duly approved applicants through your respective Regional Offices copy furnish to your Local Councils. Endorsement of the Local Council and the Regional Office do not necessarily constitute an automatic approval for participation. National Office, BSP, reserves the right to refuse and disallow participation on the merits of qualification and existing policies, rules and regulations.

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- 6. **Reporting Time.** All approved participants must report to the BSP National Office not later than 03:00 PM of 17 February 2018 for briefing and orientation and will leave BSP National Office Manila the following day 18 February 2018 at exactly 08:00 AM going to the GSP Campsite.
- 7. **Travel Itinerary.** For reference and monitoring purposes, applicants whose participation were confirmed are advised to submit their Travel Itineraries to the BSP National Office via mail at boyet.francia@scouts.org.ph
- 8. **Attire.** The participants must be in their Type "A" Scout Uniform during formal ceremonies. For the remainder of the duration of the activity, the participants are advised to strictly conform to the daily dress code and attire, as specified in the General Program and Activities (please see attached).
- Things to bring. Confirmed participants are advised to bring their own personal toiletries; cultural attire for the presentation; comfortable casual attire for the workshop proper and personal medications if any.
