WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2018



- The World Environment Day is designed to bring attention and awareness in a wide range of environmental issues which encourage people to be more vigilant in protecting the environment.
- 2. This year, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines will celebrate the World Environment Day on June 5, 2018 with its theme: "SAVE YOUR FUTURE, PLANT A TREE TODAY", through a massive tree planting activity to deliver our commitment in promoting the preservation of the environment. The activity aims to achieve the following;
 - 2.1 To engage our Scouts and Scout Leaders as agent of change towards to a healthy and cleaner air and water.
 - 2.2 Encourage Scouts, Scout Leaders and Volunteers to promote sustainable environmental protection, preservation, and biodiversity.
 - 2.3 Promoting WSEP as tools of the BSP in fulfilling its commitment to our environment
 - 2.4 Inculcating to the minds of our Scouts, Scout Leaders and Volunteers the importance of biodiversity and the effects of climate change
 - 2.5 Create partnership with public and private agencies in promoting and sustaining the preservation of our environment
- 3. In this connection, all Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives and Officers-In-Charge are hereby directed to spearhead the conduct of the celebration through tree planting activities, clean – up drives and other environmental activities from June 5 – 13, 2018. You may coordinate with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) in your respective areas for the provision of seedlings or saplings whichever is available.
- 4. After Action Reports with photos and other related documents are to be submitted in the National Office, Field Operation Division not later than June 29, 2018.
