1. We are pleased to inform you that upon invitation of the National Scout Organizations (NSO's) holding international events, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will organize separate contingents to represent the Philippines on the following events.
2. The basic information on the said events are as follows:

a.) 11th NATIONAL JAMBOREE, SCOUT OF CHINA

Date: 30 June – 06 July 2018
Venue: Taichung, Taiwan
Participants are expected to arrive on 30 June and may leave on the 06 July 2018.
Fee : Scout and Adult Leader USD250.00 and IST USD200
Deadline: May 30, 2018

b.) 5th INTERNATIONAL PATROL JAMBOREE

Date: 02-07 August 2018
Venue: Mt. Seorak (World Jamboree Complex), Gangwon Province, South Korea
Participants are expected to arrive on 02 August and may leave on the 07 August 2018
Fee : Scout and Adult Leader USD250.00 and IST USD200
Deadline: June 15, 2018

c.) 1st ASEAN ROVER MOOT

Date: 10-15 December 2018
(participants are requested to arrive on 9 December 2018 and may leave on the 16 December 2018)
Venue: Games Village Berakas, Brunei Darussalam
Fee : USD 150.00
Participants: Rover Scout (aged 17-26 years old and Adult Leaders (aged 27-40 years old)
Deadline: 31 July 2018

3. Qualification of Participants:

Scout Applicants

- Duly registered Scouts
- Must be physically fit and in good health
- The Scout must have attended BSP Regional/National Jamboree

Scout Leader Applicants

- Duly registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines
- Must be physically fit and in good health
- The applicant must have attended BSP Regional/National Jamboree

International Service Team Applicants

- Duly registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines
- IST applicant should be 18 years of age
- Must be physically fit and in good health
- The IST applicant must have attended BSP Regional/National Scout Jamboree as National Service Team (NST)

Mode of Selection: The National Office, BSP reserves the right to select the members of the delegation based, firstly on qualification and secondly, on a first reservation acceptance basis.

All prospective participants attending international scout jamboree **MUST** attend the pre-jamboree training to be conducted by the BSP National Office.

4. **Documentation:** Qualified participant must be holder of a valid Philippine Passport, which can be obtained at the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) Consular Office located in various cities/provinces nationwide.

- Birth Certificate with NSO Security Paper
- Parent Marriage Contract with NSO Security Paper

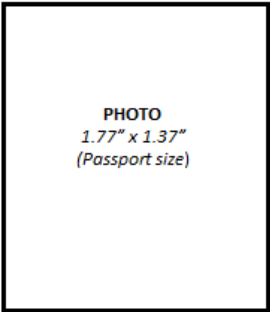
