

**SUBJECT :** WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2019

1. This year the Boy Scouts of the Philippines will spearhead the World Environment Day together with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the Local Government of Pagsanjan Laguna on June 5 – 6, 2019 with the theme: **"SCOUTS FOR CLEAN AIR"** through tree planting and water conservation to deliver our commitment in combating air pollution and promoting a clean and healthy environment.

  - 2.4 Create partnership with public and private agencies and communities in promoting a sustainable clean air and water.

In this connection, all Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives, and Officer-In-Charge are hereby directed to spearhead the conduct of the World Environment Day Celebration through tree planting activities, clean – up drives and other environmental activities on June 5 – 6, 2019 in support to the said event.
