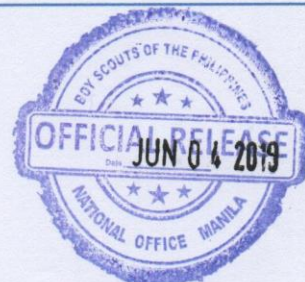

6. International Health Travel Insurance (policy)
7. E-Ticket Roundtrip – Manila-Los Angeles-Charlotte-Los Angeles-Manila
8. WSJ Health Completed
9. Valid Identification Card (Driver License, SSS, GSIS, Company ID, etc.)


