SUBJECT : OPLAN B-P at the 17th National Scout Jamboree

- Christmas season is the season of giving, compassion and generosity as we have come to celebrate our upcoming 17th National Scout Jamboree this 1 – 7 December 2019 at the Camp Kainomayan, Botolan, Zambales with the theme "Saving Lives", the National Project Management Team together with the host Ramon Magsaysay Council, BSP, and the Local Government Unit of Botolan, Zambales, have conceptualized and developed the OPLAN B-P at the Jamboree, as the first and largest Christmas Gift-Giving Outreach Programme and Initiatives during a Scout Jamboree for the benefit of the indigenous young people in the province of Zambales.
