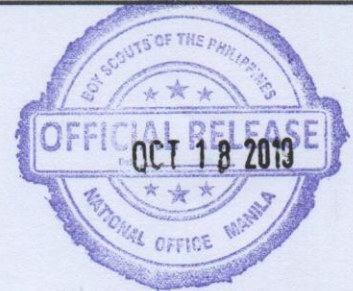

SUBJECT : MONITORING REPORT OF BSP TREE PLANTING AND ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVITY


