NESAPH 1ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND CONCLAVE

- The National Eagle Scouts Association of the Philippines (NESAPh) is pleased to announce the holding of its 1<sup>st</sup> General Assembly and Conclave on 28 February - 1 March 2020 at The Camp Resort, Brgy. Pritil, Guiguinto, Bulacan.
- 2. Aims and Objectives. At the end of the General Assembly and Conclave, all Members shall be able to:
  - 2.1. Review the Accomplishment Reports of each Chapters;
  - 2.2. Participate in the Ratification of the Constitution and By Laws;
  - 2.3. Welcome new Members who will undergo the National Acceptance Ceremony;
  - 2.4. Participate in the creation of NESAP's Calendar of Activities and Observances, and
  - 2.5. Elect National Officers.
- 3. Qualifications. The following are the qualifications for the participating Members, viz:
  - 3.1. Must be a bona fide member of the National Eagle Scouts Association of the Philippines;
  - 3.2. Must be of good moral character, and
  - 3.3. Must be able to participate in the decision-making process of the Association.
- 4. **Registration Details.** Stated below are important details regarding the Assembly Registration System and Procedure, viz:
  - 4.1. Registration Fee. A Registration Fee of TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (₱2,800) only shall be charged from each participant in order to defray administrative costs, program materials, lodging, food provisions, souvenirs, and other operating expenses.
  - 4.2. **Registration Form.** All Members who will attend the 1<sup>st</sup> General Assembly and Conclave are requested to fill out the enclosed NESAPh's Membership Profile Form which will also serve as the Registration Form of the event.
  - 4.2. Registration Site. The outgoing National Treasurer will collect all fees on 28 February 2020 from 2000H 2200H at the venue of the assembly.
- 5. Chapter Participation. The participation to the General Assembly and Conclave will come from the current eight (8) Chapters of NESAPh. Each Chapter is expected to send at least three (3) representatives to the assembly, preferably the Chapter President, Vice President, and Secretary.
