SUBJECT: 2020 NATIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM FOR MINDANAO

 The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the conduct of the National Scout Youth Forum for Mindanao at the City Triangle Building, Davao City Council Board Room, Roxas Avenue, Davao City on March 10-12, 2020.

- 2. The Scout Youth Forum, as part of the Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for youth participation in the decision-making process in the Scout Movement. It is a place for information, training and concrete experience of discussing and acquiring a deeper understanding of various issues. It is also a source of inspiration by providing contact with new people, fresh ideas, innovative thoughts, different experiences and working methods.
- 3. **General Qualifications**. For an individual to qualify for a Youth Forum, the following standards must be met:

For Senior Scouts:

- a. Must be currently registered Senior Scouts from Grade 7 to 11
- b. Must have been elected in prior levels of the Scout Youth Forum

For Accompanying Adults:

- a. Must be currently registered adult leaders
- b. Must have been officially designated by the Regional Office
- c. Must be fully conversant about the Scout Youth Forum

*All attendees must wear the official Type A Scout uniform.

4. **Participation.** Relative to the revised guidelines on the conduct of the Scout Youth Forum promulgated through National Office Memorandum No. 15, series of 2014, each Region shall send six (6) official Forum delegates, duly elected by their respective Regional Scout Youth Forum. Likewise, there must only be two (2) Accompanying Adults per region, duly designated and endorsed by the Regional Scout Director.

- 5. Each region is also allowed to send a maximum of six (6) observers to the Scout Youth Forum, but shall have no voting rights. The voting rights of those Scouts duly elected to represent their respective regions to the National Scout Youth Forum are strictly NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- 6. Registration Fee is FREE. All expenses are duly subsidized by the National Office.
- Reporting Time. All attendees must report to the venue on March 10, 2020 for the Opening Ceremonies before 1400H and must stay until the Closing Ceremonies on March 12, 2020. Food will be served from March 10 (PM Snacks and Dinner) up to March 12 (Breakfast to PM Snacks).
- 8. **Special Instructions**. Participants are advised to bring the following: (a) reference materials, (b) laptops, (c) civilian clothes, including jackets and (d) medicines, if necessary.
