SUBJECT : WEBINAR SERIES FOR ALL ADULTS IN SCOUTING

1. **Background.** Pursuant to the National Office Memorandum No. 42, Series of 2020, with Subject: Guidelines in the Conduct of Regular Scouting Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) during Covid-19 Global Pandemic as the "New Normal" Situation Classified under the GCQ, MGCQ, ECQ and MECQ, respectively, the National Office, BSP, is pleased to announce the holding of Webinar Series for All Adults in Scouting for the Month of July.

Adults in Scouting are vital resources and key actors in the delivery of quality, relevant and equitable **youth programme** for the Scouts. They represent the principal component in the realization of the Vision of Scouting for the future. Well-trained, educated, self-directed, motivated, task-oriented and performance-based, intuitive and highly competitive adults are essential to the survival, stability and integrity of the Movement.

2. **Rationale.** As a **learning organization**, it is therefore imperative for the Movement to establish a framework for the growth and development of Adults in Scouting and for each NSO/NSA to provide sustainable capacity building mechanism for its Adult Resources. As Scouting is an **educational movement**, and continues to be relevant in today's society, so it must keep itself abreast with rapid change and modernization, undergo self-examination in the light of the emerging and contingent educational philosophies and approaches, and move forward with renewed strength and vigor in its educational engagement thereby becoming a potent vehicle for **social transformation**.

Thus, the Webinar Series for all Adults in Scouting was conceptualized and developed by the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, National Office, after the recently concluded Online Adults in Scouting Committee Meeting and the National Training Commission Meeting held last June 17 and 19, 2020, respectively, with end view of providing an opportunity for Unit Leaders, Trainers, Commissioners, Leaders of Adults, Board Members, and Members-at-Large to update and further build their capacity to support the delivery of quality youth program to our members.

3. **Aim and Objectives.** The Webinar Series aims to provide an online venue for all Adults in Scouting to update themselves in the recent development in youth program, build and strengthen their leadership capacity in this time of global pandemic and to provide assistance and support to our Scouts and their leaders towards Scouting at home and Scouting online. It further seeks to engage Scout Leaders to exchange ideas on how to better promote Scouting at Home and Scouting Online as well as to share the best practices of their Sponsoring Institutions, Local Councils and Regions in this time of health crisis.

the end of the Webinar Series, the participants should be able to:


1. Familiarize themselves with the recent changes and development in the areas of Youth Program, particularly the Better World Framework and the Scouts for SDGs;

 - b. **Commissioners.** These may include National / Regional / Council / District Commissioners, Program / Training / Public Relations / Community-Based Scouting Commissioners
 - c. **Leaders of Adults.** These are National / Regional / Council Executive Board Members who provide administrative and logistical support to the Unit Leaders and Commissioners.
 - d. **Members-at-Large.** These are National / Regional / Council / District Committee Members for both Standing, Special and Adhoc Committees and Sub-Committees
 - e. **Training Team Members.** These are Wood Badge Holders with CML, Assistant Leader Trainers, and Leader Trainers.

- f. **Professional Scout Executives.** These are National, Regional, Council Scout Executives, Directors and Staff.
6. **Quota of Participation.** The Zoom account is limited to the first One (100) Hundred participants on first come and first serve basis. Each Scouting Region is allotted a maximum of ten (10) participants composed of Unit Leaders, Program and Training Commissioners, Lay Leaders and Professional Scout Executives. This Online Webinar Series is FREE OF CHARGE.
7. **Issuance of Certificate of Participation and Completion**
- a. **Certificate of Participation** – 100% attendance and active participation during the Webinar proper, including activities, recitation and small group discussions. An electronic copy of the Certificate of Participation will be send to the participants' registered email address.

This may include but are not limited to reflection journal, essay writing, and question and answer at the later part of the webinar.
