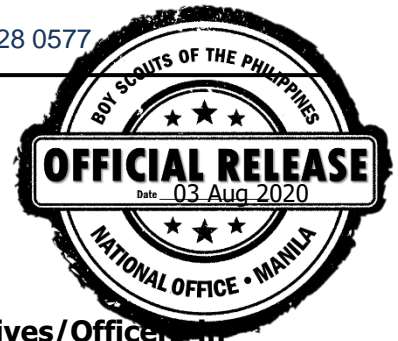

TO : Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives/Officers in Charge

SUBJECT : 2020 Search for the Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines

1. To give due recognition to our Scouts who have best epitomized the Scouting spirit of the Scouting Movement, have strictly maintained adherence to the Scout Oath and Law, and demonstrated sterling qualities of his/her leadership in the institution and community, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the **2020 Search for the Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines (TOBS)**.
2. The search is open to currently registered Senior Scouts who are Filipino citizens, at least 15 to 19 years old, holder of at least a Venturer Scout Rank and must have not reached 19 years old at the *time of nomination*. To encourage greater participation and involvement of Senior Scouts for the Search, anyone who have known probity can nominate any Scout who meets the criteria. The standard Nomination form must be accomplished by the Nominator, and jointly certified ***under oath*** by the Troop Leader, Institutional Head and the parents. The nomination form must be submitted on or before September 15, 2020 through email at bsp@scouts.org.ph/zeonvaldez100781@gmail.com or send it through mail to:

3. Nomination Form submitted to the TOBS Search National Secretariat will be subject for initial screening and to be forwarded to their respective Local Councils for their validation and recommendation to the Regional Selection Committee.

5. For the purpose of equity, the Regional Office can nominate as many qualified nominees to represent their Region for the National Level Search.
6. Cash prizes, plaques and medallions will be given to the regional winners. The Local Councils of the winning Scouts and the Schools represented by the National winners will likewise be given each Plaque of Recognition. The National winners of The Outstanding

Boy Scouts of the Philippines for 2019 will receive trophies, medals and cash prize of Php 25,000.00 each.

7. The uniform criteria for the selection are as follows;

A. Institutional Accomplishment (25%)

- A.1 Scholastic standing from first to current year in high school
 - Academic grades as certified by the School Principal/Director
 - Rank in class as certified by the School Principal/Director
- A.2 Institutional awards received
 - Honors and awards received based on school records as certified by the School Principal/Director
- A.3 Membership/Participation on Institutional Activities
 - Institutional projects involvement/participation certified by the head of the of the organization
 - Certificate of membership of the organization/institution involve with
 - Character recommendation certified by the head of the organization/institution
- A.4 Other institutional leadership and activities spearheaded/participated in
 - Positions in school-based co-/extra-curricular organizations
 - School-based activities organized indicating the level (international/national/ regional/division/school)
 - School-based activities participated in indicating the level (international/ national/regional/division/school)

B. Community Accomplishments as a Scout (50%)

- B.1 Community-based leadership and activities spearheaded and participated in response to the 17 UNSDGs
- B.2 Participation in international, national, regional, council and institutional scouting activities
 - Jamborees, training programs and skills camp participated in should be evidenced by the photocopy of activity certifications issued for the purpose. In lieu thereof, a certification of the Institutional Head/Council Scout Executive/Regional Director concerned should be presented.

September 15, 2020 - Deadline of submission of the Nomination Form for the TOBS Candidate to the TOBS Secretariat at the BSP National Office for initial screening

September 25, 2020 – Deadline of Initial Screening of nominees at the BSP National Office

September 27, 2020 – Submission of the National Office on the result of the Initial Screening to the Local Council

October 10, 2020 - Deadline for submission of recommendation and validation report and Initial Documents of the nominated Scouts of the Local Council to the Regional Selection Committee.
