17th NSJ just turned a parade of regional emblems

An array of Scouters was formed at the Jambo Food Hub that signalled the start of the much awaited Jamboree Fiesta, one of the highlights of the culminating day of the 17th BSP Scout Jamboree held at Camp Kainomayan, San Juan, Botolan, Zambales, 2pm of Dec. 6.

Tinatayang 5,000 iskawts mula sa iba't ibang councils ang nakilahok sa ginanap na 'test run' sa pagbuo ng napakalaking 'Jambo Neckerchief' gamit ang pinagtaggi-tagging mga BSP Scarves na isinagawa pagsapit ng ika-6 na araw ng 17th National Scout Jamboree.

Ininatuparan ang naturang gawain upang mabatid kung kakayanin nga ba ng Pilipinas na mapabilang sa Guinness Book of World Record bilang may pinakamalaking nagawang neckerchief sa buong mundo.

"Pilipinas pa lamang ang gumagawa, sinusubukan pa lamang. This is just a test run or dry

run upang malaman kung kaya natin and it turns out na kaya naman pala," ani Carmelo Francia, tagapangasiwa ng nasabing gawain.

Kaugnay nito, ang kabuuang sukat ay 137x135 feet na binabalak pang lakihan at taasan kung sakaling maging nominado at mapaunlakan sa Guinness World Record.
