SUBJECT: MESSENGERS OF PEACE (MoP) EVALUATION SURVEY

1. In line with the direction of the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM) to conduct a Final Evaluation Feedback through an Online Survey of the Messengers of Peace (MoP) Initiatives, the National Office, BSP, would like to enjoin everyone to take at least 10 Minutes of your time to share with us your feedback about our participation, engagement and involvement in various programs, projects and activities tagged under the Messengers of Peace (MoP) Initiative.
2. The Online Survey has two (2) category: 1 for the National Scout Organization (NSO) Leadership and Stakeholders' Survey and the 2nd one is for The Scouts and Leaders Survey, which you may access to the links provided below, viz:
