SUBJECT

2020 SCOUTING MONTH CELEBRATION AND 84TH BSP CHARTER ANNIVERSARY

- Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1326, S. 1974, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will celebrate its 84th BSP Charter Anniversary and the 2020 National Scouting Month on October with the Theme, "Commitment to Excellence".
- The purpose of the celebration is to showcase to the public and the stakeholders, the contribution of the BSP to nation-building over the past eighty-four (84) years, through the development of the young people by actively engaging and supporting them to become agents of change in their respective communities.

Specifically, the celebration aims to:

- 2.1. Promote BSP as foremost in developing the young people to become agents of change in their communities in education, peace and environment development;
- 2.2. Celebrate with thanksgiving, the founding anniversary of the BSP;
- 2.3. Instill in the minds and hearts of the Filipino youth, a sense of pride and belongingness to an international youth organization; and
- 2.4. Foster camaraderie among members as brothers and sisters in Scouting.
- 3. The highlights of the celebration will include the following activities:

- 4. Local Councils are encouraged to online hold activities relevant to the theme in support of the celebration. To ensure that the objectives are achieved, it is vital that activities be focused on the following areas:
 - 4.1. Environmental Projects and Activities geared towards the attainment of the World Scout Environment Badge or any badges under the Green is Go! Go for the Real Thing! Project (e.g. protecting water resources, energy conservation, planting trees, recycling waste)
 - 4.3. Leadership, Character and Skills Development
 - 4.4. Challenging and Adventurous Activities
 - 4.5. Patriotism and Nationalism
 - 4.6. Community Service and Community Development
 - 4.7. Council Court of Honor
- 5. All Regional Scout Directors are enjoined to monitor the activities of the Councils in their respective regions and are to submit After-Activity Reports, complete with photos and/or videos, not later than 15 November 2020.

1. MY BEST SELFPEACE

- Open for Kid and Kab Scouts
- Participant shall take his selfie photo with a folded paper crane (bird) as background
- One (1) selfie picture for each entry

2. TIKTAKTOK CHALLENGE

- Open for a Group (3-5 FAMILY members) wherein at least one member should be a Scout or a Scout Leader.
- Participants shall do a minimum of 30-second dance challenge showing Scouting-related moves and symbols in high resolution video.
