SCOUTS GO GREEN CHALLENGE - A TREE PLANTING CONTEST

- 1. In commemoration of the 84th Founding Anniversary of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, we are pleased to announce the Scouts Go Green Challenge.
- 2. The Scouts Go Green Challenge is a Tree Planting Contest open for all Scouting Units in the various Local Councils of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines to commence from 15 October 2020 to 31 December 2020.
- 3. Hereunder is the procedure and criteria for the Scouts Go Green Challenge a Tree Planting Contest, to wit:
 - 3.1. Each Scouting unit is encouraged to conduct tree planting activity at homes, schools, public plazas, parks, coastal areas, forest areas, watershed areas, campsites and other suitable areas for tree planting, following the minimum and safety protocol standard issued by the IATF, as part of the environmental and ecological program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - 3.2. Pictorials and narrative report, indicating the number of trees, the participants, the planting area and other relevant matters and information of the planting activity/ies conducted from 15 October 2020 to 31 December 2020 shall be prepared and submitted to National Office, as verified and confirmed by the respective Local Council Executive;
 - Financial incentive and Certificate of Recognition will be awarded to the Scouting Units with the most number of trees planted during the period, as follows:

First Prize -	First 10 Scouting Units with the most - number of trees planted	Php 5,000.00/each
Second Prize -	Second 10 Scouting Units with the - most number of trees planted	Php 3,000.00/each
Third Prize -	Third 10 Scouting Units with the - most number of trees planted	Php 2,000.00/each

- 3.4. Scouting units may coordinate with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), through the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) and Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) for the their seedlings and saplings requirements for the tree planting challenge.
