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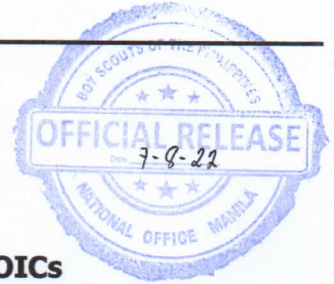

### NATIONAL OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**TO : All Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives and OICs**  
**SUBJECT : 2022 Search for the Ten Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines**

- I. Through the years, the winners of the Search are highly regarded as worthy sons of the Country, taking active roles in the community and creating positive impact on the Society. Since the beginning of the Search in 1989, it has produced hundreds of Outstanding Scouts who are serving the organization in different ways.
- II. This year, to continue giving due recognition to our Scouts who worked hard to go up the ladder of advancement and live up to the ideals of Scouting, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce a face-to-face conduct of the 2022 Search for the Ten Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines (TOBS) starting July 25 to October 26, 2022.
- III. General Qualifications:
  - A. **Currently registered** Senior Scouts (Filipino Citizens) who have not yet advanced to the Rover Scout Section;
  - B. **15 to 19 years old** upon nomination;
  - C. **Venturer Scout** or **Eagle Scout**
  - D. Private /Public School students who have a **general weighted average of at least 85%**, and with **no grades lower than 80%** in all subjects taken during the last 2 years. Students under the Alternative Learning System, as well as Community-Based Scouts, must have at least **Satisfactory Assessment** as certified by their Institutional Head.
- IV. Criteria:
  - A. Application of Scouting Skills for Self-Reliance and Preparedness (30%)
    - A.1 Actual evaluation of Scouting skills (as earned during Advancement) by the Skills Panel
    - A.2 Degree of preparedness exhibited in responding to situations as certified by a professional emergency responder
    - A.3 Awards, recognitions and public testimonials related hereto
  - B. Impact of Community Service (30%)
    - B.1 Relevance and impact of Community Service Projects Led
    - B.2 Awards, recognitions and public testimonials related hereto
  - C. Character as a Scout and Youth Leader (20%)
    - C.1 Living up to the Scout Oath and Law
    - C.2 Accounts of leadership in the institution and community
    - C.3 Maintaining a well-rounded character
  - D. Personality (20%)
    - D.1 Ability to communicate and connect
    - D.2 Clarity and organization of ideas
    - D.3 Language proficiency specially in English
- V. Anyone who has knowledge of the outstanding work of a qualified Scout can nominate. The Nomination Form must be duly accomplished by the Nominator. 
