SUBJECT: Scouts Go Green, In Celebration of BSP's 86th Year Founding Anniversary

- In celebration of its 86th Year Founding Anniversary, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines will
  undertake a Nationwide Tree Planting activity under the Scouts Go Green Project throghout
  the month of October, with a goal that every Scout will plant and nurture at least two (2)
  trees to be planted in a year.
- Local Councils are advised to look for a planting site, preferably, campsites, schools and home backyards, public plazas and parks, coastal areas, watershed areas and other suitable areas for tree planting.
- It is encouraged to plant indigenous and endemic trees such as narra, acacia, yakal, mangkono, batikuling, teak Tree, mapilig for forest and watershed areas, flower and fruit bearing trees for schools, homes, public parks and plazas and mangrove trees for coastal areas.
- For seedlings and saplings requirements, you may contact and coordinate with the
  Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), through the Community
  Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) and Provincial Environment and Natural
  Resources Office (PENRO).
- Your participation in this Tree Planting Activity will certainly contribute in the preservation of our environment from global warming.
- After Action Report, with details on the number of trees planted, number of participants, location and other necessary information with pictorials, must be reported and submitted to National Office not later than 15 November 2022 or one month after the conduct of the said activity.
