NOMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF LOCAL COUNCIL'S

EARTHTRIBE CHALLENGE COORDINATORS FOR TIDE TUNERS PLASTIC CHALLENGE

(TTPC) AND CHAMPION FOR NATURE CHALLENGE (CNC).

- The World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM), in collaboration with the World Wildlife
 Fund, Solarafrica and Greenpeace, is providing an integrated environmental conservation,
 awareness and protection structure program called EARTH TRIBE to address the climate change
 issues.
- EARTH TRIBE is a global community of young people who are passionate about the environment
 and actively engaged as global citizens to preserve and protect our planet. It is also an initiative
 centered around the educational area of environment and sustainability.

This educational area is focused on four (4) learning paths, namely: (a) Better Choices; (b) Nature and Biodiversity; (c) Clean Energy; and (d) Healthy Planet.
