SUBJECT 2023 SEARCH FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON

- 1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the **2023 Annual National Search for** the Most Outstanding Council Chairperson. The search is open to duly elected Council Chairperson from all Local Councils nationwide, whose outstanding performance of their duties and functions in the over-all implementation and administration of Scouting programs, projects and activities for the year 2022 have contributed immensely in the achievement of the BSP's Key Strategic Priorities as stated in the BSP Performance Evaluation Scorecard.
- 2. **Background and Rationale.** The Adults in Scouting Committee (AIS) of the National Executive Board (NEB) has already met twice since it was reconstituted for CY 2021 - 2022, last 23 August and 08 December 2021, respectively. Primarily, the AIS Committee aims to craft policies, procedures and quidelines that will help ensure all Adults in Scouting are highly motivated, trained, competent and duly recognized with their efforts and contributions to Scouting, especially in the areas of program implementation and quality training for leaders. Hence, the new and revised guidelines, mechanics and procedures were adopted and approved by the NEB during its meeting last 21 January 2022.
- 3. Aim. The Annual Search for the Most Outstanding Council Chairperson aims to recognize the exemplary and outstanding performance of duly elected Council Chairperson whose significant contributions in the youth development program of Scouting in their respective jurisdiction have created an impact and positive change to the lives of young people in their communities, despite of the challenges brought about by the COVID19 Pandemic.
- 4. Qualification. The search is open to all duly elected Local Council Chairperson from 124 Local Councils nationwide who have exemplary performed the mandate of their duties and functions of their elective position. Must be have significant tenure in Scouting as Council Chairperson and at least a graduate of Basic Training Course for Commissioners or Leaders of Adults.
- 5. **Nomination Process.** The nomination shall be **OPEN TO ALL** registered and qualified **Council** Chairperson. Nomination shall include an "Executive Summary" or brief narrative as to why the nominee has qualified for the award and deserves due recognition as the Most Outstanding Council Chairperson. This should clearly expound on the Nominee's significant impact and extraordinary contribution to the cause of Scouting towards the community and the young people.
- 6. The Search Committee shall **check, verify and validate all nominations** received thru the Regional Office where the nominee is registered. Nominations can be made by any duly registered Adult Leader or any member of the Regional Scout Committee and/or the Local Council Executive Board of good moral character with first-hand information or knowledge about the Nominee's tenured involvement, participation and leadership in Scouting in the Local Council.

7. Selection Process.

- 1. All nominations shall be submitted to the National Office, BSP, addressed to the Adults in Scouting Committee for initial screening and assessment.
- 2. Once qualified, the Committee, thru its Secretariat will formally notify the candidate, thru its Local Council, that the Nomination has been officially accepted. This also includes a notice to submit pertinent documents to support the nomination of the candidate.
- 3. The Committee will schedule a Panel Interview with the Candidates.
- 8. **Revised Criteria for Judging.** The revised criteria for judging shall focus on the performance of duties and responsibilities pursuant to the AIS Policy and at the same time, their significant contributions to the Local Council with respect to the BSP's Performance Evaluation Scorecard, anchored on BSP's Key Priority Areas and NP's 8 Point Key Performance Agenda.

- 1. Scouts helping create better communities by integrating community service projects and tree planting in their Council Activities under the Better World Framework and Scouts for SDGs.
- 2. Appropriate recognition conferred to Scouts and Adults in Scouting through the number of Scouts advanced to the next higher rank and number of adults received their National Awards.
- 3. Introduced Scouting to More Young People as a positive measure of Membership Growth.
- 4. Enable Adults in Scouting to be competent Leaders of Scouts through the number of quality trainings conducted.
- 5. Development of Business Enhancement Systems through timely compliance to quality standards and required reports by the Regional Office and/or National Office.
- 6. Sustainable Revenue Streams for Organizational Stability through resource generation and mobilization of resources other than membership fees.

The announcement of winners will be highlighted during the BSP's 66TH Annual National Council Meeting on 10 -12 May 2023 in Visayas. National Winners shall receive a Cash Incentive, Plaque and Souvenirs.
