

**SUBJECT :** 2023 Earth Hour Celebration

1. As part of our incessant commitment to help save planet Earth, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce our continuous participation to the 2023 Earth Hour Celebration. This event aims to provide a platform to urgently promote the advocacy of addressing the planet's biggest environmental challenges and call on the world leaders to decide on a new global action plan for nature for the coming decade.
