SUBJECT: OPEN CALL FOR JAMBOREE PLANNING TEAM AND NATIONAL

SERVICE TEAM OF THE 18TH NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. Pursuant to the National Office Memorandum No. 24, Series of 2023, which formally announced the holding of the 18th National Scout Jamboree on 11 – 17 December 2023 at Passi City, Province of Iloilo, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the "Open Call for Jamboree Planning Team (JPT) and National Service Team (NST)" that will help provide technical assistance and support in the planning and implementation of the 18th National Scout Jamboree.

- 2. Jamboree Planning Team. The Jamboree Planning Team or JPT aims to recruit and organize a group of experienced, trained, committed, inspired and motivated Rovers and Scout Leaders, Commissioners, Trainers and other Lay Leaders who will provide significant insights and inputs to the different Plans of various Jamboree Services. It further seeks to ensure that the design of the Jamboree Programme is safe, inclusive, equitable, exciting, challenging, meaningful and relevant for all. It primarily supports the role of the Jamboree Organizing Committee and the Project Management Team. The JPT will also provide all necessary pre-jamboree orientation and trainings to all registered NST.
- 3. **National Service Team.** The National Service Team or NST aims to provide a readily available pool of trained, inspired and motivated volunteers focused on delivering the designed plans for the successful conduct of the 18th National Scout Jamboree. NSTs will be distributed in all areas of Jamboree Services, especially in the field of Programme and Administration.
- 4. **Qualifications.** Applicants for JPT and NST must meet the following qualifications:
 - a. Must be currently registered as a Rover Scout or Adult Leader, Lay Leader, Trainer, Commissioner aged between 19 to 60 years old
 - b. Must be physically fit as certified by a licensed physician
 - c. Must be of good moral character
 - d. Must have served in their previous Council and/or Regional Scout Jamboree
 - e. Must be at least a graduate of Basic Training Course or preferably a Wood Badge Holder
 - f. Must have completed the WOSM's Safe from Harm thru this link https://www.scout.org/what-we-do/member-organizations/child-and-youth-safety
 - a. Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment.
 - h. Must be duly recommended and endorsed by the Council Scout Executive and the Regional Scout Director

- 7. All approved JPT and NST will receive their corresponding Certificate of Appointment and Terms of Reference regarding their specific roles, assignment and designations.
- 8. **Registration Fee.** All JPT and NST shall pay the Jamboree Registration Fee of **FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php. 500.00)** shall be charged from each participant in order to defray administrative costs, program materials, souvenirs and other operating expenses.
- Reporting Dates. All JPTs and NSTs are expected to arrive at the Jamboree Site not later than 1500H, Friday, 08 December 2023, three (3) days before the official opening of the Jamboree for General Orientation, Briefing, Training and Deployment Proceedings and may leave the camp on Monday, 18 December 2023.
- 10. The Jamboree Organizing Committee, through the National Project Management Team has the right to decline and/or disapproved JPT and NST Applications on the basis of non-compliance to the requirements, qualification and Safe from Harm related issues and concerns.
