SUBJECT : ASIA-PACIFIC REGIONAL BIG 6 SUMMIT 2023

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, National Office, Manila is pleased to announce the invitation and open call for participation to the **"APR Big 6 Summit 2023"**, which will be hosted by Persekutuan Pengakap Malaysia (The Scout Association of Malaysia) in collaboration with WOSM-APR, on **15 – 18 June 2023, at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia**, under the APR Triennial Plan 2022-2025, which highlighted the "Youth Engagement" as one of its priority areas.
2. The event aims to gather key people from the Big 6 Youth Organizations to investigate how its members can be involved in a collaborative project. The main mission of the APR Big 6 Summit 2023 is to investigate and establish a collaborative, multi-stakeholder project among the young people of the Big 6 Youth Organizations, on the subject of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in one NSO.
3. The BSP is keen of endorsing at least 3 Adult Scout Leaders and 2 Youth Representatives, either a Senior or Rover Scouts, at least 18 to 26 years old, and must be currently registered with an active Unit, on first-come and first served basis.
4. Registration Fee is \$250 USD per participant to cover inland transportation, meals, accommodation for the forum duration, forum kit, documents, and souvenirs. Air fare shall be borne by the participants to and from the event venue.
5. Accommodation of summit participants will be taken care of from the night of 14 June 2023 until morning of 19 June 2023 (5 nights) and any extra nights will be at the cost of the participant/s. Participants will be accommodated in a room sharing basis. Meals shall be provided to participants from dinner of 14 June 2023 until breakfast of 19 June 2023. Those who have any special food requirements may please indicate in the reply slip.

We are pleased to inform you that Persekutuan Pengakap Malaysia, in collaboration with the Asia-Pacific Region of the World Organization of the Scout Movement, is organizing the **Asia-Pacific Regional Big 6 Summit 2023**.

One of the key performance indicators (KPIs) to achieve Objective No. 1.1 of Youth Engagement Priority in the APR Triennial Plan (2022-2025), is to organize a region-wide summit involving the Big 6 Youth Organizations is organized in 2023 to establish a cooperative project.

Therefore, this summit is aimed at gathering key people from the Big 6 Youth Organisations to investigate how its members can be involved in a collaborative project. - Investigate and establish a collaborative, multi-stakeholder project among the young people from the Big 6 Youth Organisation, on the subject of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in one NSO.

Eligibility: Key Commissioners of any level in an NSO or full-time executives responsible or in charge of Youth Programme; and/or young people between the age of 18 to 26 that have actively been involved with community projects and work related to the sustainable development goals.
