NATIONAL OFFICE MEMORANDUM

TO: All Regional Scout Directors, Council Scout Executives and OICs

SUBJECT: 2023 Search for the Ten Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines

I. In 1989, former Education Secretary and BSP National President Isidro D. Carino conceived and initiated the Search for the Ten Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines (TOBSP). He considered it a vital avenue to propagate the Department of Education's Values Education Program. The search aims to give due recognition to the most outstanding Scouts who epitomize sterling qualities of school and community leadership, academic excellence and good moral conduct, thereby serving as role models to the youth.

The quest starts at the Council level where Scouts contend to participate in the regional eliminations and to eventually represent their regions in the national finals in Manila. After a thorough scrutiny of the candidates' credentials, they undergo rigid interview with a distinguished panel of judges. Criteria for judging include leadership potential, academic proficiency, non-academic awards and recognition, personality and verbal communication.

Through the years, the winners of the search have followed a "glorious tradition of being looked up to as worthy sons and daughters of the country, ready to be of service to our people and as the cream of the crop among the youth today."

II. As we continue our journey in a post-pandemic society, we saw an opportunity to capitalize on the strength of the youth and young people through Scouting who worked hard to go up the ladder of advancement and live up to the ideals of Scouting, the Boy Scout of the Philippines is pleased to announce the conduct of the **2023 SEARCH FOR THE TEN OUTSTANDING BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES (TOBSP)** starting **August 7 to October 28, 2023**.

III. The following guidelines presented still adopting the approved recommendations of the former NEB Committee on Youth Program as per implementation of the 2022 TOBSP.

General Qualifications:

The Search is open to all active and registered Senior Scouts (Filipino Citizens) who:

- A. 15 to 19 years old upon nomination;
- B. At least a holder of a Venturer Scout Rank or preferably an Eagle Scout and not yet advanced to the Rover Scout Section or have attended or participated in a ROVIC (Rover Orientation Vigil and Investiture Ceremony);
- C. For private/public school students who have a general weighted average of at least 85%, and with no grades lower than 80% in all subjects taken during the last 2 years;
- D. For Alternative Learning System (ALS) students or Community-Based Scouts: Have at least satisfactory assessment as certified by their Institutional Head.

IV. Criteria for Judging

A. Application of Scouting Skills for Self-Reliance and Preparedness (30%)

- 1. Actual evaluation of scouting skills as earned during the Advancement (Safety, First Aid, Firemanship, Life Saving and Emergency Preparedness) by the Skills Panel;
- 2. Degree of preparedness exhibited in responding to situations as certified by a professional emergency responder;
- 3. Awards, recognitions and public testimonials related hereto;

B. Impact of Community Service (30%)

- 1. Relevance and impact of Community Service Project led;
- 2. Awards, recognitions and public testimonials related hereto;

C. Character as a Scout and Youth Leader (20%)

- 1. Living up to the Scout Oath and Law;
- 2. Accounts of leadership in the institution and community;
- 3. Maintaining a well-rounded character;

D. Personality (20%)

- 1. Ability to communicate and connect;
- 2. Clarity and organization of ideas;
- 3. Language proficiency especially in English;
- V. The uniform criteria for the selection are as follows:

A. Institutional Accomplishment (25%)

- A.1 Scholastic standing from first to current year in high school
 - Academic grades as certified by the School Principal/Director
 - Rank in class as certified by the School Principal/Director
- A.2 Institutional awards received
 - Honors and awards received based on school records as certified by the School Principal/Director
- A.3 Membership/Participation on institutional activities
 - Institutional project involvement/participation certified by the head of the organization/institution
 - Certificate of membership of the organization/institution involved with
 - Character recommendation certified by the head of the organization/institution

A.4 Other institutional leadership and activities spearheaded/participated in

Positions in school-based co-/extra-curricular organizations
 School-based activities organized indicating the level (international/national/division/school)
 School-based activities participated indicating the level

(international/national/division/school)

B. Community Accomplishment as a Scout (50%)

- B.1 Community-based leadership and activities spearheaded and participated in response to the 17 UNSDGs'
- B.2 Participation in international, national, regional, council and institutional scouting activities
 Jamborees, training programs and skills camp participated in should be evidenced by the photocopy of activity certifications issued for the purpose. In lieu thereof, a certification of
 - the Institutional Head/Council Scout Executive/Regional Director concerned should be presented
- B.3 Community-based leadership and activities spearheaded/participated in
 - Positions in community-based organizations other than the BSP
 - Community-based activities organized indicating the level (international/national/ regional/division/community)
 - Community-based activities participated indicating the level (international/national/ regional/division/community)
- B.4 Scouting activities organized
- Nature and level of activities
- B.5 Scouting activities participated in
 - Nature and level of participated in
- B.6 Awards/ Commendations received
- B.7 Church-based activities
 - Position in church-based organizations
 - Involvement in church-based activities as certified by the Parish Priest/official concerned

VI. **National Open Call for Nomination**. Anyone who has known probity can nominate any Senior Scout who is interested to join the Search and who meets the general qualifications and criteria. All nomination forms must be submitted to the National Office and will be assessed by the Initial Screening Committee. Qualified nominees will be endorsed by the National Office to the respective Local Councils for verification.

The Nomination Form must be duly accomplished by the Nominator. This form must be submitted, as a Word file and PDF file through email at **alvinsanjoaquin@gmail.com** on or before **August 25, 2023**.

VII. Local Council Validation and Endorsement to the Regional Offices. Local Councils must conduct validation and Search based on the given criteria, and must choose winners based on the quota allocated by the National Office. Council search winners will be endorsed by the local councils to their respective Regional Offices.

VIII. **Regional Search**. Regional Offices must conduct its Search based on the given criteria, and must choose winners based on the given criteria. Regional Search winners will be endorsed by the Regional Offices to the National Office. The composition of the Regional TOBS Search are as follows:
