RE: REVISED GUIDELINES IN THE CONDUCT OF THE 2023 SEARCH FOR

TEN OUTSTANDING BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES.

- 1. To duly recognize Scouts who best epitomize good moral character, have maintained academic excellence, and demonstrate authentic qualities of leadership in the institution and community, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce the 2023 Search for the Ten Outstanding Boy Scouts of the Philippines.
- 2. The search is open to all currently registered Senior Scouts who are Filipino citizen, at least 15 19 years old, holder of Venturer or Eagle Scout Rank a Private or Public School students who have a general weighted average of at least 85% and with no grades lower than 80% in all subjects taken during the last 2 years, and for students under the Alternative Learning System (ALS), as well as Community-Based Scouts, must have at least Satisfactory Assessment as certified by their Institutional Head.
- 3. Below are the following criteria for this year's search.

A. Interview (55%)

- A.1 Knowledge and Communication Skills
 - Language proficiency
 - Organization of Ideas
 - Level of relevant knowledge on social issues or issues of national concern
- A.2 Character, Values, and Personality
 - Common courtesy
 - Grooming and hygiene
 - Smartness in wearing the Scout uniform
 - Bearing and Demeanor
 - Exhibits the exemplary qualities and values of an outstanding scout

B. Application of Scouting Skills for Self-Reliance and Preparedness (30%)

- Actual evaluation of Scout skills as earned during the Advancement such as (Safety, First Aid, Firemanship, Life Saving, and Emergency Preparedness) and others.
- Degree of preparedness exhibited in responding to a situation.

C. Institutional and Community Accomplishment as a Scout (15%)

C.1 Institutional Accomplishment

- Scholastic standing from first to current year in high school which consists of academic grades as certified by the School Principal/Director and Rank in class as certified by the same authority.
- Membership/Participation in institutional activities ie; involvement/participation to Institutional projects certified by the head of the organization/institution. A certificate of membership of the organization/institution involved with, and character recommendation certified by the head of the organization/institution.
- Other institutional leadership and activities spearheaded/participated in, which indicate the level of involvement ie; (International/National/Regional/Division/School)

C.2 Community Accomplishment as a Scout

- Community-based leadership and activities spearheaded and participated in response to the 17 UNSDGs'.
- Participation and involvement in International, National, Regional, Council-wide, District-wide, and Institution scouting activities like Jamborees, Trainings, Program Seminars, and Skills Camp in should be evidenced by the photocopy of the activity certification as verified and certified true by the Institutional Head/Council Scout Executive/Regional Scout Director concerned should be presented.
- Community-based leadership and activities spearheaded/participated ie;
 - > Position in community-based organization other than the BSP
 - Community-based activities organized indicating the level (International/National/Regional/Division/Community)
 - Community-based activities participated indicating the level (International/National/Regional/Division/Community
- Scouting activities organized indicating the nature and level of activities
- Scouting Activities participated indicating the nature and level of participation in
- Awards, recognitions, and public testimonials related hereto;
- Church-based activities indicating the position in the church-based organization and involvement in the church-based activities certified by the Parish Priest/Pastors/Official based on the Scout faith denomination.
- 4. Anyone who has knowledge of the outstanding work of a qualified Scout can nominate. The Nomination Form must be duly accomplished by the Nominator. This form must be submitted as a Word file and PDF file through email at zeonvaldez100781@gmail.com on or before September 01, 2023.
