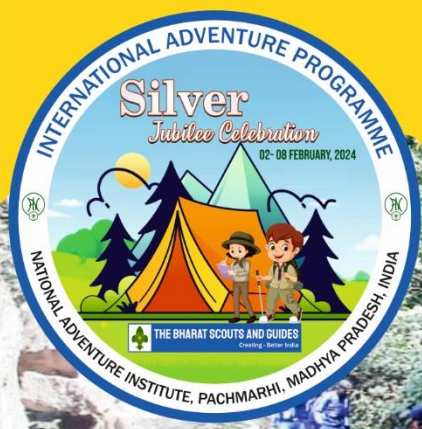

We are very happy to inform you that the 25<sup>th</sup> International Adventure Programme will be held at the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Adventure Institute, Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh, India.

The details of the Event are as under:-

Date:	02 <sup>nd</sup> to 08 <sup>th</sup> Feb. 2024. (SEVEN DAYS). (Arrival on 02 <sup>st</sup> February, before Lunch and departure on 08 <sup>th</sup> February after lunch. Travel plan may be made accordingly)
Venue:	National Adventure Institute, Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh, India
Eligibility Criteria:	Scouts/Rovers (Male/Female) and Adult Leader between the age 12 to 55 years are eligible to apply.
Fitness:	Physically and mentally fit and be able to trek for 16-20 K.M. per day. Blood Pressure, Asthma, Diabetes patients are not allowed
Camp Fee:	<b>US \$ 150.00.</b> Fee includes Inland Transportation, food, event souvenirs, accommodation, medical assistance for the injury during the programme, equipment's and other training expenses. Camp Fee can be paid on arrival during registration. Only US dollar or Indian Rupee will be accepted.
Activities:	Rock Climbing, Rappling, Trekking, Camping, Encountering of Obstacles, Valley Crossing, Zip-Line, Sky Cycling, Horse Riding, Rifle Shooting, Archery, Survival Skills, Water Activities and many more challenging and thrilling adventurous activities, Para-Sailing, Hot-air-Ballooning may also be added if situation permits.

What to bring	<b>1. Personal kit:</b> - Ruck sack, Warm cloths, Comfortable shoes, Sleepers, Cotton socks, torch, Track-suit, Mug, Plate, Spoon, Knife, thread needle, spare buttons, Note Book, writing materials, First Aid Kit/personal medicine / cream etc. toilet kits, talcum powder, personal medicines if any, Water Bottle and spare garments.



	<p>2. Participants are requested to come prepared for every day's campfire and to present cultural items. Please do not forget to carry traditional dress.</p> <p>3. Two Stamp size photo.</p> <p>4. Scout Uniform, NSO Flag, National Flag, CD of National Anthem.</p>
Special Note:	No doubt, you are physically fit, but you are advised to toughen up your leg muscles by road walk, running and skipping for at least a fortnight before reaching for Adventure Programme. While practicing, wear your same socks and shoes that you will be wearing for the programme. Accommodation will be provided in the Tent only.
Safety:	We have gone through the entire schedule bit-by-bit, route planned with the help of expert mountaineers and trekkers to keep you safe and sound. Although every possible care of the participants will be taken, The Bharat Scouts & Guides, National Adventure Institute will not be responsible for any accident, loss, illness or other unforeseen events that may occur during the programme.
Weather:	During February, Pachmarhi will be cold and the temperature of the area will be around 6 to 18 degree. Hence warm clothing's to be carried accordingly.
How to reach:	<p><b>Air:</b> The nearest Airport is Bhopal. From Delhi and Mumbai, direct flights are available for Bhopal. From Bhopal, 6 hours journey by road for Pachmarhi.</p> <p><b>Train:</b> The nearest Railway station is PIPARIYA, which is on Itarsi- Jabalpur Allahabad Railway line. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi is 56 Km by road.</p>
Quota:	Booking will be made on the basis of <b>"First Come First Serve"</b> . 100 seats are reserved for overseas participants.

All the NSO's are requested to send the details of participants on or before **31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023**. (Reply Slip attached)

We hope that your NSO will make use of this golden opportunity of having interaction with the Indian participants along with the trekking route and camping in the forest at the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Adventure Institute.
