2024 Earth Hour Celebration

- As part of our incessant commitment to help save planet Earth, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is pleased to announce our continuous participation to the 2024 Earth Hour Celebration. This event aims to provide a platform to urgently promote the advocacy of addressing the planet's biggest environmental challenges and call on the world leaders to decide on a new global action plan for nature for the coming decade.
- The Earth Hour is a worldwide grass-roots movement under World Wildlife Fund (www.wwf.org) for the planet that engages a massive mainstream community on a broad range of environmental issues. The said event is held worldwide towards the end of March annually.
- 3. Millions of Scouts and Scout Leaders from different parts of the world will be joining to take part in Earth Hour to show their support for climate change. In the Philippines, we encourage all Scouting Units, Sponsoring Institutions, District Scouting Committees, Local Councils, Regional Offices and National Office Staff and Employees to participate by switching off the lights for one hour (60 minutes) on 23 March 2024 around 8:30 to 9:30 PM local time, this can make a substantial difference in energy consumption and can help reduce the effect of global warming on this planet.
