The Scout Association of Hong Kong is organizing the "International Scout Youth Forum 2024 on Modern Technology and Scouting," on June 8-10 2024 at Hong Kong Scout Centre, Scout Association of Hong Kong Pak Sha Wan T.W.C. Sea Activity Centre.

#### **PARTICIPANTS:**

Scout youth members and leaders aged between 18 and 26 on the first day of the Forum.

#### **ACCOMMODATION:**

- BP International Hotel on 7 and 10 June 2024
- Scout Association of Hong Kong Pak Sha Wan T.W.C. Sea Activity Centre on 8 and 9 June 2024
- All accommodation will be arranged on sharing basis, and is intended for participants ONLY.

#### **REGISTRATION:**

- **USD 100/person**
- The fee covers dinner on 7 June and 10 June, as well as all meals for the duration of the youth forum, accommodation for 4 nights, transportation from the Hong Kong International Airport to BP International Hotel on 7 June, transportation from BP International Hotel to the Hong Kong International Airports on 11 June, programme activities, educational tour, souvenirs and tour pick up/drop off.
- The fee excludes additional transportation as listed above, meals and transportation before 7 June or after 10 June (in the case of early arrival / late departure), travel/medical insurance and personal consumption expenditures.

#### **ACTIVITIES**

Activities during the Youth Forum including Ice-breaking activities, team-building, input and discussion sessions, NSO sharing, educational tour, etc. For the educational tour, participants will be engaged in a local exploratory activities related to the Forum's theme and/or exchange with local Scout groups.
