Photos must reflect the theme Young People and Peacebuilding



PHOTO SIZE

File size: Up to 20 MB of image data per work

File format: JPEG/ 150 dpi recommended (Any entry less than the required resolution and size will not be accepted).



IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Participants may submit photos using smart phone cameras, digital cameras, or professional cameras.
- All are encouraged to provide a short description.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES

No limit in the number of photo entries to be submitted per person and per NSO.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Scouts and leaders registered with a National Scout Organization in the Asia-Pacific Region.

Due to maximum size requirement, please upload your entries with the accomplished forms on Google Drive or Dropbox, and send us the link.
