APPROVING THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES PERFORMANCE EVALUATION SCORECARD FOR 2023

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10149 otherwise known as GOCC Governance Act of 2011 Created the Governance Commission for Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations to evaluate the performance and determine the relevance of the GOCC, to ascertain whether such GOCC should be reorganized, merge, streamlined, abolished or privatized, in consultation with the department of agency to which a GOCC is attached, to promote financial viability and fiscal discipline in Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations and to strengthen the role of the state in its governance and management to make them more responsive to the needs of public interest and for other purposes;

WHEREAS, the GCG guided by standards prescribed by R.A No. 10149 mandated to actively exercise the State's ownership rights through the institutionalization of a Performance Evaluation System (PES);

WHEREAS, towards this end, the GCG issued GCG Memorandum Circular No. 2017 – 02 providing the guidelines and deadlines, on the preparation and submission of Performance Evaluation Scorecard annually;

WHEREAS, the BSP PES Senior Management Team in its midyear performance review for 2022 prepared the BSP PES for 2023 in accordance with the guidelines set by MC No. 2017 - 02; viz:
